AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY OWNED BY TONY A. CAMPBELL AND KATHERINE B. CAMPBELL LYING ADJACENT TO THE CITY'S BOUNDARY

WHEREAS, Tony A. Campbell and Katherine B. Campbell, being the owners of all of the land lying in the territory proposed to be annexed, have consented in writing to the proposed annexation pursuant to KRS 81 A.412; and,

WHEREAS the Calvert City Planning Commission has recommended to the City Council the annexation of the proposed territory and the zoning of the annexed territory as R-1; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the proposed annexation to be in the best interests of the City, and further has determined that the appropriate zoning designation for the annexed area is R-1.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CALVERT CITY, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, that the following described property be annexed into the City of Calvert City, Kentucky:

Lots 1 and 2 of Block 3, Lots 1 and 2 of Block 4, and the tract designated "Future Multihousing" of the Royal Park Estates Subdivision, Phase 2, more particularly described on the Plat of said subdivision recorded in Plat Book 8, page 53, Slide 454, in the Marshall County Court Clerk's Office.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the above described property is hereby designated as an R-1 zoning district, in accordance with the revised zoning map of the City of Calvert City, attached hereto and made a part hereof.

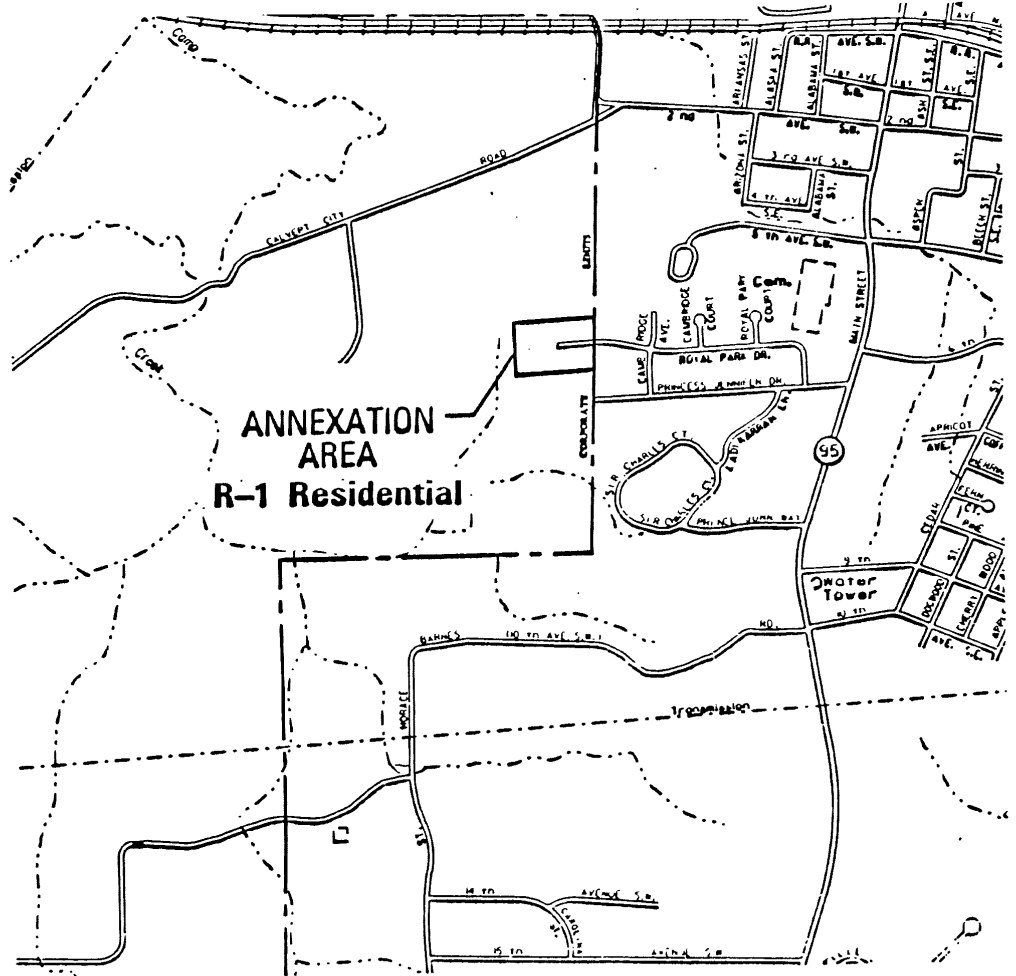
