AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND BELONGING TO ED ABELL AND IVAN BLEVINS, WHICH LANDS ARE DESCRIBED AS BEING LOTS NO. 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 AND 9 OF THE GILMORE FARM DEVELOPMENT, WHICH LANDS LIE ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT BOUNDRIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, ED ABELL and IVAN BLEVINS have made application to the Planning & Zoning Commission of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission, pursuant to KRS Chapter 100, held a public meeting on the question of annexation and zoning of the hereinafter described land; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission has formally recommended to the City Council that said land be annexed and zoned B-4;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

That that land of Ed Abell and Ivan Blevins described as follows:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8 and 9 of the Gilmore Farm Development as shown of record in Plat Book 2, page 6, Taylor County Clerk's Office, Kentucky.

be, and hereby is, annexed into and made a part of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; and further, that same be, and hereby is, zoned B-4, under and by virtue of the terms of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky.

This Ordinance was introduced and given first reading and passage at a meeting of the City Council held on the 17th day of FEBRUARY, 1986; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at the next regular meeting of the City Council held on the 3rd day of MARCH, 1986.
