AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND LYING ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT FOREST HILLS SUBDIVISION, CONSISTING OF 21.5 ACRES TO HEREAFTER BE KNOWN AS SECTION E OF THE FORST HILLS SUBDIVISION, TO THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellsville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described area, said Ordinance being read on the 2nd day of May, 1988; and the 16th day of May, 1988; and thereafter said proposed Ordinance annexing the within described property having been advertised in toto in the Central Kentucky News Journal on the 19th day of May, 1988.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the City Council of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described properties, and further the City Council does hereby declare that the annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; does further state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that prior to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:



Beginning at a point at the northeast corner of lot #130 of Forest Hills Subdivision, Section D, said point being in the line of the Willie Ray Shipp property; thence with the line of said Shipp property N 69 E 1337.5 feet to a point, corner of the Blevins & Gorin property; thence with the lines of said Blevins & Gorin property as follows: S 19 E 850.8 feet; S 63-30 W 78 feet to a point at the northeast corner of lot #104 of Forest Hills Subdivision, Section D; thence with the lines of said Forest Hills Subdivision, Section D as follows: S 71-41 W 160 feet; S 88-11 W 165 feet; N 78-55 W 149 feet; S 69 W 185 feet; N 21 W 25 feet; S 69 W 250 feet; N 21 W 150 feet; S 69 W 200 feet; N 21 W 125 feet; S 69 W 260 feet; N 7 W 430 feet to the beginning containing 21.5 acres.

This property is hereby zoned R-1.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 1st day of August, 1988; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 15th day of August, 1988.

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO ANNEX INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND LYING ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT FOREST HILLS SUBDIVISION, CONSISTING OF 21.5 ACRES TO HEREAFTER BE KNOWN AS SECTION E OF THE FOREST HILLS SUBDIVISION, TO THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, Blevins & Gorin, a Kentucky general partnership, has made application to the Planning & Zoning Commission of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, The Planning & Zoning Commission, pursuant to KRS Chapter 100, has held a public hearing under the date of April 26, 1988, on the question of annexation, and of zoning of the hereinafter described land; and

WHEREAS, the Planning & Zoning Commission has formally recommended to the Common Council that said land be annexed and zoned R-1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A and specifically KRS 81A.420, the City of Council of Campbellville, Kentucky does hereby state its intention to annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described property; and further the City Council does hereby declare that the proposed annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky; and further the City Council does hereby state that the area is urban in character and is an unincorporated territory.

The property to be annexed shall be zoned R-1.

The land to be annexed is described as follows:

A certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Campbellville, Taylor County, Kentucky, and being described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the northeast corner of lot #130 of Forest Hills Subdivision, Section D, said point being in the line of the Willie Ray Shipp property; thence with the line of said Shipp property N 69 E 1337.5 feet to a point, corner of the Blevins & Gorin property; thence with the lines of said Blevins & Gorin property as follows: S 19 E 850.8 feet; S 63-30 W 78 feet to a point at the northeast corner of lot #104 of Forest Hills Subdivision, Section D; thence with the lines of said Forest Hills Subdivision, Section D as follows: S 71-41 W 160 feet; S 88-11 W 165 feet; N 78-55 W 149 feet; S 69 W 185 feet; N 21 W 25 feet; S 69 W 250 feet; N 21 W 150 feet; S 69 W 200 feet; N 21 W 125 feet; S 69 W 260 feet; N 7 W 430 feet to the beginning containing 21.5 acres.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 2nd day of May, 1988; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at the next regular meeting of the City Council held on the 16th day May, 1988.
