

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY CERTAIN PROPERTIES LYING ON ~~U.S.~~ Ky. HIGHWAY 70, BELONGING TO DAN WATSON.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described area, said Ordinance being read on the 21st day of June, 1982, and the 5th day of July, 1982, and thereafter said proposed Ordinance annexing the within described property having been advertised in toto in the Central Kentucky News Journal on the 5th day of August, 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the Common Council of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described properties, and further the Common Council does hereby declare that the annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky; does further state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that prior to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

Parcel No. 1 - Next to Cemetery:

Beginning at a stake on the North side of Highway 70, said stake being a corner to a cemetery; thence with the North right of way of aforesaid highway S 53° W 100.5 feet to a stake; thence dividing the lands of Dan Watson N 51° 30' W 327.5 feet S 41° W 69.5 feet N 68° 40' W 53 feet S 48° 50' W 62 feet to a stake in property owned by Charles Nolley; thence with Nolley's line N 37° 50' W 141 feet to a steel pin and corner to Nolley; thence N 44° E 217 feet to a post and corner to aforesaid cemetery; thence with the property line of said cemetery S 51° E 532 feet to the beginning containing 1.67 acres, more or less.

Parcel No. 2 - Home

Beginning at a stake in the North right of way of U.S. Highway 70, said stake being located 100.5 feet S 53° W from a stake marking the corner of a cemetery; thence from the beginning stake a division line in the land of Dan Watson N 51° 30' W 327.5 feet S 41° W 69.5 feet N 68° 40' W 53 feet S 48° 50' W 62 feet to a stake in Charles Nolley's line; thence with said Nolley's line S 37° 50' E 200 feet to an iron stake; thence S 42° 10' W 213 feet to a stake on the East side of aforesaid highway; thence with the right of way of said highway S 73° E 91 feet N 81° E 50 feet N 64° 10' E 50 feet N 53° E 300 feet to the beginning containing 1.97 acres more or less.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the Common Council held on the 1st day of November, 1982; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the Common Council held on the 15th day of November, 1982.
