AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE COR-PORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND LYING IN TAYLOR COUNTY IN THE FOREST HILLS SUBDIVISION AND BELONGING TO JAMES LARRY BEN-NINGFIELD AND HIS WIFE, BECKY BEN-NINGFIELD.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellsville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described area, said Ordinance being read on the 21st day of November, 1988, and the 5th day of December, 1988.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Lying and being in Taylor County, Kentucky, and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEING Lot No. 64 of the Forest Hills Subdivision according to plat of the Forest Hills Subdivision, Section C, which is found of record in Plat Book 1, page 107, records of the Taylor County Court Clerk's Office, Campbellsville, Kentucky. (Subject to the Restrictions of the Forest Hills Subdivision as set forth in Miscellaneous Book 10, page 27, office of the Taylor County Court Clerk, Campbellsville, Kentucky).

This being the same property conveyed to Charles C. McVey and his wife, Joanne McVey, by Deed of Patrick O. Judd and his wife, Linda T. Judd, dated December 19, 1984 and of record in Deed Book 153, page 185, Taylor County Court Clerk's Office, Kentucky.

This property is hereby zoned R-1.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 19th day of December, 1988; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 4th day of January, 1989.
