

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE
CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY
OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY CER-
PROPERTIES LYING IN SOUTH CAMP-
BELLVILLE BELONGING TO WELBY
SIMPSON.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described area, said Ordinance being read on the 15th day of August, 1983, and the 6th day of September, 1983, and thereafter said proposed Ordinance annexing the within described property having been advertised in toto in the Central Kentucky News Journal on the 8th day of September, 1983.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the Common Council of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described properties, and further the Common Council does hereby declare that the annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky; does further state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that prior to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.


The land hereby annexed is described as follows:


THIRD TRACT: Being a certain tract of land beginning at the southeast corner of lot No. 2 of the division of the lands of Arthur Brockman and Lillie Brockman Farm, a plat of which is of record in Deed Book 26, page 118-119, records of the Taylor County Court Clerk's office, Ky.; thence S 55½ E 40 feet to a stake corner to lot No. 3 of said Arthur Brockman and Lillie Brockman Farm; thence S 1 E 200 feet to a stake; thence S 55½ E 534 feet to a stake; thence S 70 W 1172 feet to a stake; thence N 46½ W 291 feet to a stake; thence N 31½ E 872 feet to a stake corner to lot No. 2 of said Farm; thence S 82 E 252 feet to the beginning, containing 17.1 acres be the same more or less.

FOURTH TRACT: A certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Taylor County, Kentucky in the City of Campbellville and being described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the southeast side of Roland Street, corner of the Jeff Reynolds property; thence with said Roland Street N 35 E 24.42 poles to a stake on the southeast side of said Roland Street, this being a new division corner in the Rainwater property also the new corner of the Dan Watson property; thence with a new division line in the property of Rainwater, this also being the new line of the Dan Watson property S 47½ E 58.5 poles to a stake, another new division corner in the property of said Rainwater, this also being a new corner of the Dan Watson property; thence with the line of the B & W Auto property S 29 W 28.42 poles to a fence post, corner of the B & W Auto property and the Jeff Reynolds property; thence with the line of said Jeff Reynolds N 47 W 62.5 poles to the beginning, containing 10 acres more or less.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the Common Council held on the 21st day of November, 1983; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at the next regular meeting of the Common Council held on the 5th day of December, 1983.
