ORDINANCE NO. 95-001

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TRACTS OR PARCELS OF LAND LYING IN TAYLOR COUNTY AND BELONGING TO KENTUCKY LANDMARK COMPANY.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellsville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described area, said Ordinance being read on the 7th day of November, 1994, and the 5th day of December, 1994.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the City Council of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described property; and further, the City Council does hereby declare that the annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; and, further, the City Council does hereby state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin corner to Kentucky Landmark Co. (Deed Book 182 page 372), which iron pin bears N 25 degrees 41 minutes E 53.20 feet; thence N 49 degrees 15 minutes E 571.28 feet from the east intersection of Wesley Drive with Kentucky Highway #3183; thence from said beginning corner and running with the line of Kentucky Landmark Co. N 40 degrees 45 minutes W 730 feet to an iron pin corner to Kentucky Landmark Co. and Fred Faulkner, Jr. (Deed Book 127 page 547)(Deed Book 174 page 197) now Kentucky Landmark Co. (Deed Book 185 page 652)(Deed Book 190 page 638); thence following division lines N 69 degrees 27 minutes E 196.16 feet to a steel pin; S 72 degrees 20 minutes E 260.70 feet to a steel pin; N 49 degrees 15 minutes E 779.38 feet to a steel pin at top of a bluff; thence following the bluff S 40 degrees 45 minutes E 440 feet to a steel pin at the northwest side of a reservoir; thence a division line S 49 degrees 15 minutes W 1111.90 feet to the beginning, containing 12.85 acres.

This property is hereby zoned R-2.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 3rd day of January, 1995; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 6th day of February, 1995.
