ORDINANCE NO. 98-006

AN OPDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TRACTS OR PARCELS OF LAND LYING IN TAYLOR COUNTY AND BELONGING TO TOMMY AND LOIS DAFFRON.

WHEREAS, the above named persons have proposed to the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, an Ordinance to annex and zone the within described area, said Ordinance being read on the 6th day of April, 1998, and the 4th day of May, 1998.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A and specifically KRS 81A.420, the City Council of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, does hereby state its intention to annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described property; and further, the City Council does hereby declare that the proposed annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; and, further, the City Council does hereby state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and is an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

A certain tract or parcel of land lying in and being in Taylor County, Kentucky and being Lot No. 10 of the Golf Court Sub-Division, a plat of which is found of record in Deed Book 47 Page 612, records of the Taylor County Court Clerk's Office.

This being the same land conveyed by deed to Thomas E. Daffron and his wife, Lois C. Daffron by C. S. Hagan and his wife, Doris Hagan which deed is dated the 30th day of March, 1974, recorded in Deed Book _____, page 93, records of the Taylor County Clerk's Office, Kentucky.

The above described property is subject to all right-of-ways and easements, whether implied or of record.

This property is hereby zoned R-3.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 1st day of June, 1998; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 6th day of July, 1998.




ANNEXATION MAP (NOT FOR LAND TRANSFER)
