AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN PROPERTIES LYING ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE AND BELONGING TO GARY HASH, LORETTO HASH, ALVIN RICHERSON, FAYOLA RICHERSON, CHRISTINE G. GABEHART, JAMES E. GABEHART, PAUL JOHNSON, JR., JOAN JOHNSON, ANCIL WOOD AND BLONDINA WOOD.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellsville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described areas, said Ordinance being read on the 1st day of March, 1982, and the 15th day of March, 1982, and thereafter said proposed Ordinance annexing the with described property having been advertised in toto in the Central Kentucky News Journal on the 22nd day of April, 1982.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the Common Council of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described properties, and further the Common Council does hereby declare that the annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; does further state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that prior to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

Ancil Wood Tract No. 1:
Beginning at a post along the North side of the
Barr Tract Road, corner to land owned by the Commonwealth of Kentucky; thence with same N 36-40 W 931'
to a point; thence N 52-45 E 220' to a steel rod
corner to Lot 64, Section Three, Highland Subdivision; thence with the line of the Subdivision
N 38-15 W 87.4 to a steel rod; thence N 51-45 E
668.5' to a steel post, at the Northwest corner
