AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE  
CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY  
OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY,  
APPROXIMATELY 12.04 ACRES OF LAND,  
MORE OR LESS, BELONGING TO FRED  
FAULKNER, JR., AND HIS WIFE,  
HELEN F. FAULKNER, LYING JUST  
OFF OF KENTUCKY HIGHWAY 210 AND  
ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF CAMP-  
BELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, ON THE  
WATERS OF TRACE CREEK.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellsville has heretofore pro-  
posed an Ordinance to annex the within described area, said  
Ordinance being read on the 6th day of July, 1981, and the 20th  
day of July, 1981, and thereafter said proposed Ordinance annex-  
ing the within described property having been advertised in toto  
in the Central Kentucky News Journal on the 23rd day of July,  
1981.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF  
THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the  
Common Council of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, does  
hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Camp-  
bellsville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described properties, and  
further the Common Council does hereby declare that the annexa-  
tion is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellsville,  
Kentucky; does further state that the area to be annexed is urban  
in character and that prior to the annexation it was an unin-  
corporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

A certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in  
Taylor County, Kentucky and being described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of Pitman Creek, corner of the Sam Cox property and Forest Hills Subdivision; thence with the lines of said Forest Hills Subdivision as follows: N 37-13 E 300 ft.; N 44-13 E 191 ft. to an iron pin in the line of said Forest Hills Subdivision, said iron pin being a division corner in the Fred Faulkner, Jr. property; thence with division lines in said Faulkner property as follows: S 85-44 E 40.3 ft.; N 47-26 E 20 ft.; S 42-34 E 760 ft. to a point on the north side of the proposed Trace Fork Road; thence with the north side of said proposed road S 38-45 E 375 ft. to a point on the north side of said proposed road; thence with division lines in said Faulkner property as follows: N 49-15 E 200 ft.; S 40-24 E 455.6 ft.; S 49-15 W 200 ft. to a point on the north side of said proposed road; thence with said proposed road S 25-41 W 53 ft. to a point at the northeast corner of the intersection of said proposed road and Kentucky Highway #210; thence with the north side of said Kentucky Highway #210 as follows: N 62-46 W 20 ft.; N 65-53 W 20 ft. to a point at the northwest corner of the intersection of said proposed road and said Kentucky Highway #210; thence with the southwest side of said proposed road as follows: N 25-41 E 27 ft.; N 40-45 W 311 ft. to an iron pin on the southwest side of said proposed road, corner of Lot #6 of Trace Fork Estates; thence with the line of said Lot #6 S 47-57 W 177 ft. to an iron pin, corner of said Lot #6; thence with the line of said Lot #6 and then the line of Lot #5 and then the line of Lot #4 N 38-45 W 375 ft. to an iron pin in the line of Lot #3 of Trace Fork Estates, corner of said Lot #4; thence with the line of said Lot #3 S 47-57 W 112.5 ft. to an iron pin in the line of said Sam Cox property, corner of said Lot #3; thence with the lines of said Sam Cox property as follows: N 23-29 W 82.3 ft.; N 40-59 W 191 ft.; N 59-26 W 282 ft.; S 58-19 W 13 ft.; N 66-56 W 328 ft. to the beginning containing 12.04 acres more or less.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the Common Council held on the 21st day of September, 1981; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the Common Council held on the 5th day of October, 1981.
