AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN PROPERTIES LYING ADJACENT TO THE SOUTHERN STATES PROPERTY IN THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF THE INTERSECTION OF EAST BROADWAY [HIGHWAY 208] AND THE AIRPORT ROAD AND THENCE WITH THE SOUTHWEST SIDE OF SAID AIRPORT ROAD SOME 1690 FEET.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described areas, said Ordinance being read on the 15th day of December, 1980, and the 5th day of January, 1981, and thereafter said proposed Ordinance annexing the within described property having been advertised in toto in the Central Kentucky News Journal on the 15th day of January, 1981, and thereafter having been once again advertised in the Central Kentucky News Journal under date of March 5, 1981;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the Common Council of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described properties, and further the Common Council does hereby declare that the annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellville, Kentucky; does further state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that prior to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

A certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Taylor County, Kentucky and being described as

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follows: Beginning at a point at the corner of the Southern States property and the southwest corner of the intersection of East Broadway [Highway #208] and the Airport Road; thence with the southwest side of said Airport Road S 41 E 1619 ft. to a stake on the southwest side of said Airport Road, corner of the Taylor County Stockyard Property and the Carl Smith farm; thence with said Taylor County Stock Yard Property and the Carl Smith farm S 53 W 761.3 ft. to a stake, corner of said Taylor County Stockyard property and the Carl Smith farm; thence with said Taylor County Stockyard property and then the Carl Smith property N 41-24 W 1145 ft. to a stake on the northwest side of the L & N Railroad property; thence with the northwest side of said L & N Railroad property and the Southern States property, crossing said Airport Road and with the Eugene Russell property N 48½ E 2309 ft. to a point on the northwest side of said L & N Railroad property, corner of the Eugene Russell property and being on the south side of East Broadway [Highway #208]; thence with the south side of said Highway #208 [East Broadway] S 64 W 1595 ft. to the beginning, containing 28.5 acres more or less.

This being a part of the land of Carl Smith and the lands of Eugene L. Russell and his wife, Mary Ann Russell.

This Ordinance was introduced and received its first reading at a ^{SPECIAL} regular meeting of the Common Council held on the 17th day of March, 1981; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a REGULAR meeting of the Common Council held on the 6 day of APRIL, 1981.


