ORDINANCE NO. 02-13

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TRACTS OR PARCELS OF LAND LYING IN TAYLOR COUNTY AND BELONGING TO SHIRLEY CARTER

Whereas the City of Campbellsville has heretofore received the request for annexation by the owner of the property more particularly described below, thus dispensing with the necessity of an Ordinance proposing annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the City Council of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described property; and further, the City Council does hereby declare that the annexation is requested by the property owner, and is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; and, further, the City Council does hereby state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

Tract #1:

Beginning at a post on the south side of old U.S. 68, said post being corner common to Elizabeth Sanders and Arnold Denton; thence, with the south right of way line of U.S. 68 N 70 degrees 30' E 100 feet to a state; thence, a division in the land of Elizabeth sanders S 14 degrees 00' W 100 feet to a stake in the line of Arnold Denton; thence, with Denton's line N 14 degrees 00' W 100 feet to the beginning containing 1/4 acres more or less.

Tract #2:

Beginning at a stake along the south side of West Main Street, corner to Tune-Up Center, Inc. Lot; thence with the right-of-way of West Main Street N 76 degrees 30' E 10 feet to a stake; thence a new division line S 12 degrees 15' E 70 feet to a stake (a new corner); thence S 70 degrees 30' W 10 feet to a stake, corner to Tune-Up Center Lot; thence with said Lot N 12 degrees 15' W 70 feet to the beginning.

These tracts being all or a part of the same property conveyed to Shirley Carter by deed dated <u>Set 25, 1971</u>, of record in Deed Book <u>107</u>, Page <u>463</u>, records of the Taylor County Court Clerk's office, Kentucky.

The property is zoned B-4.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 3rd day of June, 2002; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 1st day of July, 2002.




