AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY CERTAIN PROPERTIES LYING ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, ON HIGHWAY #527.

WHEREAS, the City of Campbellsville has heretofore proposed an Ordinance to annex the within described area, said Ordinance being read on the 21st day of December, 1987; and the 4th day of January, 1988; and thereafter said proposed Ordinance annexing the within described property having been advertised in toto in the Central Kentucky News Journal on the 7th day of January, 1988.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY AS FOLLOWS:

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS Chapter 81A, the City Council of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, does hereby annex into the corporate boundaries of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky, the hereinafter described properties, and further the City Council does hereby declare that the annexation is desirable to the needs of the City of Campbellsville, Kentucky; does further state that the area to be annexed is urban in character and that prior to the annexation it was an unincorporated territory.

The land hereby annexed is described as follows:

## FEE TRACT

A certain parcel of land located at the intersection of Dale Street and Kentucky Highway 527 (Saloma Road) near the City of Campbellsville, Taylor County, Kentucky, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the west right of way of Kentucky Highway 527, said point being approximately 230 feet south of a common corner of the Gene Cash property and the remainder of the William Lee Phillips property; thence leaving said point and with the right of way line of Kentucky Highway 527 (Saloma Road) S 22 deg. 14 min. E 100 feet to a point in the intersection of north right of way of Dale Street and the west right way of Kentucky Highway 527 (saloma Road); thence with the north right of wy of Dale Street S 65 deg. 00 min. W 200 feet to a point; thence leaving the north right of way of Dale Street N 22 deg. 14 min. W 100 feet to a point; thence 65 deg. 00 min. E 200 feet to a point in the west right of way of Kentucky Highway 527 (Saloma Road), the point of beginning, according to the survey of Robert L. Miller, Jr., Kentucky Registered Land Surveyor No. 2282, said survey dated December 5, 1986.

## EASEMENT TRACT;

THERE IS FURTHER CONVEYED HEREIN, a permanent and perpetual non-execlusive easement for ingress and egress over a portion of the Grantors remaining property of record in Deed Book 126, page 275, Deed Book 131, page 217, and Deed Book 140, page 616, all in the taylor County Court Clerk's office, said easement being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the west right of way of Kentucky Highway 527 (Saloma Road), said point being approximately 230 feet south of a corner common to the Gene Cash property and the remainder of the William Lee Phillips property; thence leaving the west right way of Kentucky Highway 527 S 65 deg. 00 min. E 200 feet to a point; thence N 22 deg. 14

min. W 60 feet to a point; thence N 65 deg. 00 min. E 200 feet to a point in the west right of way line of Kentucky Highway 527 (Saloma Road); thence with said right of way S 22 deg. 14 min. E 60 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is hereby zoned B-2.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 21st day of March, 1988; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 4th day of March, 1988.
