This Ordinance shall become effective after passage and publication as required by law.

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO ANNEX INTO THE CORPORATE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE, KENTUCKY CERTAIN PROPERTIES LYING ADJACENT TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CAMPBELLSVILLE AND BEING FURTHER IDENTIFIED AS LOT NO. 25 OF THE FOREST HILLS SUBDIVISION AS SHOWN BY PLAT RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 1, PAGE 71.

Section B






ANNEXATION MAP
