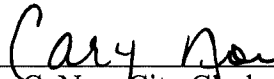

feet to a stake; thence a new division line south 17 1/2 E 339 feet to a stake at the north edge of said highway; thence with said highway south 79 1/4 west 10 feet to the beginning.

PARCEL IV

Beginning at a stake on the North edge of the State Road Rite of Way and at the corner of the lot owned by Joe Philips and Runs with his line N.16 1/2 W 284 feet to a Stake in the line of Dollie Compton, thence with her line N.48 3/4 E 100 feet to a stake thence S. 17 1/2 E 339 feet to a stake at the north edge of said road Rite of Way, thence with same s. 79 1/4 W.100 feet to the beginning.

PARCEL V

Beginning at a stone on the north side of the Campbellville to Greensburg State Hlghway; thence with the north side of said Hlghway, N 79-1/4 E 213 feet to an iron stake, corner to Underwood; thence with the line of Underwood, N 13 W 125 feet to an iron stake; thence S 64-1/2 W 236 feet to the beginning.

PARCEL VI

Beginning at a stake at the intersection of the Friendship road and the Greensburg road and runs with the Friendship road N. 47 W. 272-3/4 feet to a stake, thence N. 78-1/4 E. 156 feet to a stake, thence S. 47 E. 272-3/4 feet to a stake at the Greensburg road #70, thence with same less. Said Greensburg road is the one and same road as State Hlghway #70.

PARCEL VII

Lot #4 of the Roots Addition to Taylor County, Kentucky according to Plat dated February 27th, 1961 of record in Deed Book 26, page 132 records of the Taylor County Court Clerk's office.

PARCEL VIII

Beginning At A Stake Or Stone On The North Side Of State Road No 68 And 70 And At The Corner Of The Lot Owned By William Bault And Runs With His Line N.10.3/4.E 170 Feet To A Stake Or Stone In The Old Back Line Thence With Same And The Line Of Dollie R. Cumpton N.49.1/2.E.115.Feet To A Stake Thence S.11/1/4.E.237 Feet To A Stake At The Road Thence With Said Road N.78.1/2.W.100 Feet To The Beginning

PARCEL IX

Beginning At A Stake On The State Road No 68 And 70 On The North Edge Of Said Road Rite Of Way And Runs With The Line Of Hugh G. Moss As Following N.10,1/4.W.237.Feet To A Stake In The Line Of Dollie Compton Thence With Her Line N.48.3/4.E.90 Feet To A Stake Thence S.16.E.284.Feet To A Stake At The Road Thence With The Road Thence With The Road S.79.W.100.Feet To The Beginning

PARCEL X

Beginning at a point in the center of the Friendship Road corner to Lula Joyce Hubbard and husband; thence with the center of said Road N 49 1/2 W 119.5 feet; thence continuing with the center of said Road N 34 1/2 W

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258.5 feet to the point in the center of said Road on the southeast side of Thomas Avenue; thence with Thomas Avenue N 49° E 178 feet to a point on the southwest side to Lula Joyce Hubbard and husband; thence with their line S 56 1/2° W 192 feet to the beginning.

PARCEL XI

Lot No. 5 of the Roots Addition to plat of record in Deed Book 26, page 132, Taylor County Court Clerk's office, Kentucky, and said lots fronts on the said Lula Avenue 100 feet and extends back between parallel lines 140 feet.

These properties are hereby zoned R-3.

BARBARA WARREN

Beginning at the corner to Lot 3 of Warren Place Subdivision Section One at the west right of way of Warren Place thence with the limits of previously annexed area for Warren Place Section One N 22° 32' W, 60 feet; N 35° 15' E, 509.34 feet & S 38° 11' E, 52.17 feet to a point in the line of Lot 8 of Warren Place Section One; thence with Lot 8 N 35° 15' E, 189.50 feet to a steel rod corner to Lot 8 in the line of Callison; thence with Callison N 15° 30' W, 20.50 feet to a steel post corner to Callison & Taylor County Hospital Health Facility (D.B. 164 page 378); thence with said hospital property N 36° 47' W, 587 feet to the line of Jerry Bennett; thence with Bennett & others 564° 24' W, 900 feet to a corner to another tract of Warren (Deed Book 165, page 426); thence with said tract of Warren S 38° 11' E, 1056 feet to a steel post corner to Lot 3 of Warren Place Section One; thence with Lot 3 N 35° 15' E, 179.20 feet to the beginning & containing 16.0 acres by this description as prepared from survey conducted by B.R. Edelen RLS#1782.

This property is hereby zoned R-1.

WOODLAWN CHRISTIAN CHURCH

FIRST TRACT: Beginning 18 feet east of the property line of Richard Shipp corner to Phillip Corbin at a point on the south side of U.S. Highway 68 that leads from Campbellsville to Greensburg, Kentucky; thence east with said Highway approximately 200 feet (being the same distance that the Woodlawn school ground faces said Highway), corner to Philip Corbin; thence south with the line of Corbin approximately 20 feet, corner to Woodlawn school ground; thence west with the Woodlawn school line approximately 200 feet, corner to Philip Corbin and 18 feet from the line of Richard Shipp; thence north with the line of Philip Corbin a distance of approximately 20 feet to the beginning.

SECOND TRACT: Known as the Woodlawn School Property & bound as follows: Beginning at a black jack in the line between B.W. Campbell and N.H. Mathews; thence running North west 99 yards to a stake; thence southeast 99 yards to a stake; thence east 66 yards to the beginning. But there is reserved and now sold hereby the 18 foot wide passway on west side of this property over said land as set out in deed mentioned.

THIRD TRACT: Beginning on the south side of U.S. Highway 68 and Kentucky Highway 70 that leads from Campbellsville to Greensburg, Kentucky, corner to Richard L. and Henrietta Shipp; thence with said highways N 79 degrees 40 minutes E 202 feet corner to Norman R. Corbin; thence with the line of Corbin S 11 degrees 30 minutes E 222 feet, another

corner of Corbin to Shipp; thence with the line of Shipp N 9 degrees 40 minutes W 225 feet to the point of beginning. But there is reserved a certain passway 18 feet wide on the west side of this property and which lies adjacent or next to the land of Shipp.

PARCEL II

Tract No. 1. Beginning at a stake on the South side of the Campbellsville to Greensburg State Ilhighway, which stake is directly in line with the division line between the property originally owned by B.F. Smith and the Woodlawn School Property, thence with the right of way of said Highway in a Southwesterly direction 150 feet to a stake; thence a division line parallel with the West line of the Woodlawn School Property and leaving the State Ilhighway right of way to a stake in the line of Smith; thence with the original line N 81 E 150 feet to a post, corner to the Woodlawn School Property; thence to the Beginning, being a narrow strip of land lying immediately between the property conveyed to B.F. Smith to Richard L. Shipp and wife and the Campbellsville to Greensburg State Ilhighway.

Tract No. 2. Beginning at a post in the Old Greensburg dirt road, corner to the Woodlawn School Property and Harry P. Fawcett, thence with the line of Fawcett, S 81 W 150 feet to a stake in the original line; thence a division line S 12 E 376 1/2 feet to a stake in the original line of Smith; thence with the original line of Smith

PARCEL III

Beginning at a steel rod along the south side of West Main Street, a corner to Tract #1, thence with Tract #1 S 12-35 E 270 feet to a steel rod; thence S 82 W 66 feet to a steel rod corner to Woodlawn Christian Church land; thence with same N 7-45 W 269.5 feet to a point along West Main Street; thence with same N 82 E 55 feet more or less to the beginning. This tract contains 0.37 acre.

These properties are hereby zoned B-2.

This Ordinance was introduced and given a first reading and passage at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 1st day of October, 1990; it received its second reading, passage and became effective at a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 15th day of October, 1990.
