CORRECTED FINDINGS OF FACT, CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND JUDGMENT

It appearing that certain mistakes and inconsistencies appear in the original judgment entered in this cause on July 20, 1963, and by agreement of the parties and the court being advised and pursuant to CR 60.01, said findings of fact, conclusions of law and judgment is now corrected as follows:

## FINDINGS OF FACT

The words "that except for the territory hereinafter specifically described" is deleted from Findings of Fact No. 6 and said finding is corrected and shall read as follows:

6. The court finds as a fact that the part of the area proposed to be incorporated into said City and lying on the westerly side of the Russell Fork of the Big Sandy River is not adapted or adaptable for any municipal use.

## JUDGMENT

In the third call of the description establishing the boundary of the City the figure "2640 feet" was included by mistake and said figure is now deleted from the third call as contained in the boundary description and said description establishing the boundary of the City is accordingly corrected and shall read as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on hillside, East of Road and bearing S 650 00' E 310 feet from mouth of Chestnut Hollow; thence up hillside and crossing point N 840 QQ' E 2640 feet to stake on center spur of Elswick Hollow; thence S 60 00' E 2640 feet crossing ridge, railroad, Beaver Creek and highway to a stake on hillside; thence down Beaver Creek on South side, S 840 00' W crossing Ky. 80 highway to a point in the low water mark on the westerly side of the Russell Fork of the Big Sandy River; thence turning to the right and running with the low water mark in said river; thence N 60 00' W 1750 feet running back across the river on a line to the point of BEGINNING.

Except for the corrections above entered said Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Judgment of July 20, 1963, shall remain in full force and effect.
