# ORDINANCE #92-2

## AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING AN AREA OF CENTRAL CITY TO BE KNOWN AS THE "EVERLY BROTHERS FOUNDATION ANNEXATION"

WHEREAS, Ordinance  $#91-\underline{17}$  (KOC  $#\underline{1/0.46}$  ) was passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Central City, Kentucky, on Movember 13, 1991, which Ordinance was an annexation proposal ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said annexation proposal ordinance was published pursuant to law on November 20, 1991; and

WHEREAS, no petition has been received by the Mayor in opposition to said proposed annexation, pursuant to Kentucky Revised Statute 81A.420; and

WHEREAS, more than sixty (60) days have elapsed since the publication date of said annexation proposal ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

- That the territory described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, is hereby annexed into the City Limits of the City of Central City, Kentucky, and shall henceforth be a part of the City of Central City, Kentucky. Said territory is also contained in a map or plat attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.
- Pursuant to the recommendation of the Joint City-County Planning and Zoning 2. Commission, and KRS 81A.420, the above described annexed territory shall be zoned B-2, General/Highway Business, as to the property west of U.S. Highway #431, and R-3, Residential, Single or Multi-Family, as to the property east of U.S. Highway #431, as marked on the map or plat attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, and an appropriate map amendment to the City's zoning map shall be made pursuant to this ordinance.
- The City Clerk of the City of Central City, Kentucky, shall cause a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed with the Muhlenberg County Clerk and with the Kentucky Secretary of State for recording in said Offices.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as 4. required by law. This the 15th day of April


