ORDINANCE FILLING A VACANCY ON THE CITY COUNCIL CAUSED BY APPOINTMENT OF A MEMBER OF CITY COUNCIL TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF MAYOR

WHEREAS, BARRY SHAVER, A MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, WAS ELECTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF MAYOR CAUSED BY THE RESIGNATION OF JERRY L. MITCHELL AS MAYOR; and

WHEREAS, PURSUANT TO KRS 83a.040, IT IS THE DUTY OF THE REMAINING MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO FILL THE VACANCY ON CITY COUNCIL CREATED BY SUCH CITY COUNCIL MEMBER BEING ELECTED BY CITY COUNCIL TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF MAYOR.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CENTRAL CITY, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Shannon Combs shall fill the unexpired term of Barry Shaver as a member of the City Council, which unexpired term runs through December 31, 2006.

This is an emergency ordinance which shall take effect immediately, it having passed by at least a two thirds (2/3) majority. The emergency consists of an immediate need to fill the vacancy on City Council created as aforesaid.


