J U D G M E N T

At a Court held April 24th 1951.

This cause coming on to be heard, and it appearing to the Court from the records herein that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in two issues of the Louisville Times on February 17, 1951 and February 21, 1951, said newspaper being published in and of general circulation in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and it further appearing to the Court and the Court being satisfied from the verified petition herein that the population within the boundary described in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of law in such cases and no defense having been imposed herein, it is now ordered, adjudged and decreed:

1. That a town by the name of Cherrywood Village be and is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class within the following described boundary, as more fully described and shown by a map filed with the petition herein, said boundary being described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point which is in the intersection of a line running 125 feet North of the North line of Massie Avenue and parallel therewith, and a line running 125 feet East of the East line of St. Matthews Avenue and running parallel therewith; thence running Northwardly and parallel with St. Matthews Avenue to a point 125 feet South of the South line of Flint Road; thence running Eastwardly and parallel with Flint Road to a point even with the East line of Cherrywood Road; thence running Southwardly and parallel with Cherrywood Road to a point 125 feet North of the North line of Massie Avenue; thence running Westwardly and parallel to Massie Avenue to the point of beginning.

2. That there are hereby appointed as the Board of Trustees of said town the following named persons residents therein, to-wit, W. K. Karow, George C. Hummel, Thomas H. Wright, Charles C. Meyer and Ernest Woodward, II, and William Peden as Police Judge thereof, William W. Gladden as Marshall thereof and Charles Peage as Assessor thereof; each of said Trustees and officers shall hold their respective offices until the next General election, at which officers for cities and towns may be elected and until their successors shall have been elected and qualified.

That the clerk of this court, not later than ten days after the judgment is entered herein, certify a copy of this judgment to the Secretary of State, whose duty it shall be to properly index and file the same as a permanent record in his office.

The qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law and by taking the respective oaths of office and executing the respective bonds and obligations prescribed by law which shall be entered upon the records of said town.
