
CERTIFICATE TO COMPLY WITH KRS 81.045

RE: City of Claysville, Webster County, Kentucky


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT THE CITY OF CLAYSVILLE was duly incorporated by an act of the Kentucky Legislature on February 25, 1860, while at that time a part of Union County, Kentucky. Upon the formation of Webster County, Kentucky, the City of Claysville became a part of Webster County. The City of Claysville, now commonly known as Clay, is presently classified as a fifth class city, and attached hereto is a copy of the present corporate limits of said city.

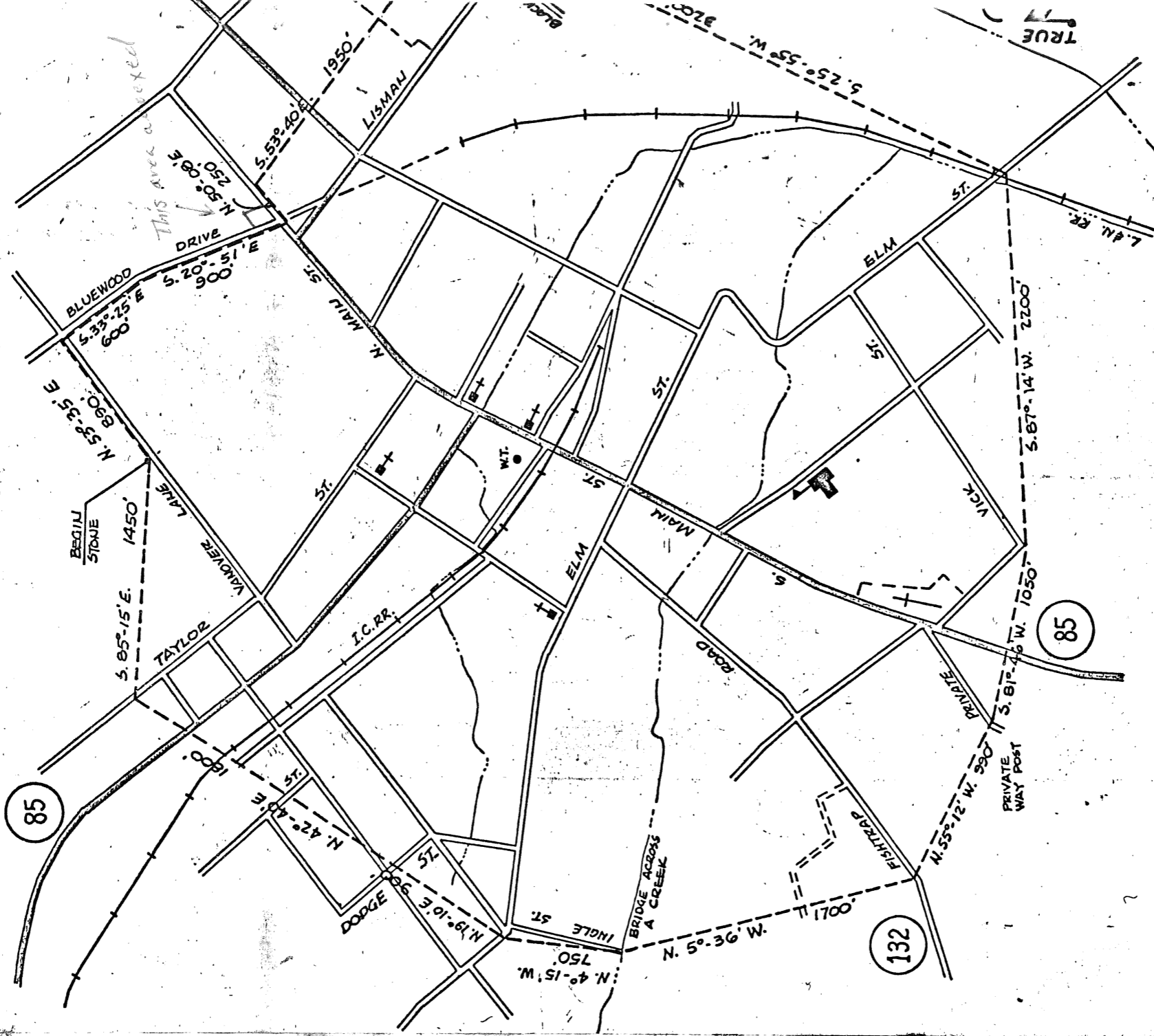
