COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY CITY OF COLD SPRING ORDINANCE NO. 05- 863

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED
TERRITORIES WITHIN THE COUNTY OF CAMPBELL, KENTUCKY
AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE PRESENT BOUNDARY LINES OF THE
CITY OF COLD SPRING, KENTUCKY, A CITY OF THE FIFTH CLASS
AND DEFINING BY METES AND BOUNDS THE TERRITORY ANNEXED AND
PRIOR TO SECOND READING REQUESTING THE COLD SPRING PLANNING
AND ZONING COMMISSION TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING AND MAKE
RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING THE APPROPRIATE ZONING FOR THE
PROPERTY

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statute 81A.410 authorizes and delegates city legislative bodies the authority to annex territories; and

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statute 81A.412 provides the manner in which said annexation should be accomplished through the consent of the property owner; and

WHEREAS, the property owner, by way of an annexation agreement, has provided written consent to the annexation; and

WHEREAS, the property herein described is adjacent to and contiguous to the city's boundaries; and

WHEREAS, Kentucky Revised Statute 100.209 allows the Cold Spring Planning and Zoning Commission to conduct a public hearing and make recommendations for the zoning and land use regulations; and

WHEREAS, by reason of population density, commercial, industrial, institutional or governmental use of land, or subdivision of land, said property is urban in character or suitable for urban purposes without unreasonable delay; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COLD SPRING, KENTUCKY:

SECTION I

That the City of Cold Spring does hereby and herewith annex to its present

boundaries and include the same within the territorial limits of the City of Cold Spring, Campbell County, Kentucky, the following described unincorporated land and area, located in the County of Campbell, Commonwealth of Kentucky, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Right-of-Way line for the AA Highway, said point of beginning being 102.08 feet Left (North) of the roadway centerline Station 138+79.03, and said point being approximately 913 feet west of the intersection of KY Route 9 and the AA Highway; thence along an existing fence line common to excess Right-of-Way (R/W) purchased by the KY Transportation Cabinet (Deed Book 512, page 107, Parcel 38X) North 18 degrees 45 minutes 23 seconds East a distance of 841.05 feet to an iron pin in a fence line common to Geiman (Deed Book 418, page 273); thence with Geiman's line N. 89-09-25 E. 256.52 feet to an iron pin and S. 85-43-05 E., 99.01 feet to an existing iron pipe in the ground; thence along fence line common to Groote (Deed Book 530, page 57) S. 19-09-05 W., 780.38 feet to a R/W monument for the AA Highway to be set at 250.00 feet LT STA 142+22.32; thence with the R/W line for the AA Highway N. 75-25-43 W., 122.58 feet to a R/W Monument; S. 14-36-20 W., 138.67 feet to a R/W monument; N. 79-09-30 W. 100..60 feet to a 2.25 inch diameter fence post in the R/W line; and N. 76-10-33 W., 120.73 feet to the point of beginning and containing 6.402 acres.

SECTION II

That pursuant to KRS 100.209, the Cold Spring Planning and Zoning Commission shall conduct a public hearing, prior to second reading of this ordinance, and upon having considered the appropriate zoning for the aforementioned territory at a duly noticed and called public hearing, the Cold Spring Planning and Zoning Commission recommended to the City Council of Cold Spring that said territory be zoned HC. The City of Cold Spring hereby adopts said recommendation and the property to be annexed shall be zoned HC, the attached map of the territory is incorporated by reference herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION III

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication and recording, according to law.

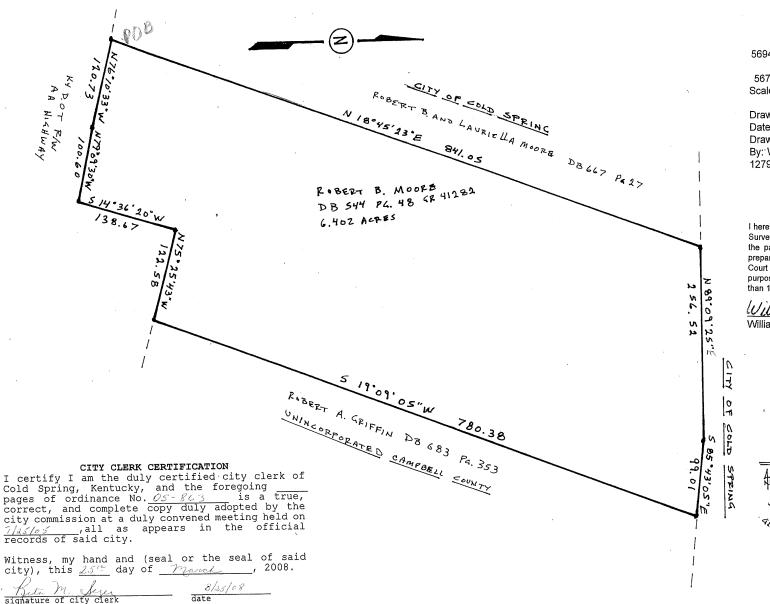
