# ORDINANCE NO. 110.19 AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND AND ENLARGE THE CORPORATE LANDS OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 81A.412, et seq., Tucker Yarberry has requested that the City of Columbia, Kentucky annex a portion of land contiguous to the City located in Murray Subdivision on Murray Lane;

WHEREAS, the annexation of said property would appear to be for the benefit of the City of Columbia;

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 100.209, et seq., the Columbia Planning and Zoning Commission has followed the statutory procedure and has recommended that the subject property be classified as Zone R-1A when the property is annexed into the City of Columbia, instead of as Zone R-1, which would be its classification otherwise, and the City Council has taken final action with regards to the recommendation of the Columbia Planning and Zoning Commission by enacting Ordinance No. 920.50 pursuant to which the subject property will be classified as Zone R-1A when it is annexed into the City of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, the statutory requirements having been met, it is the intention of the City of Columbia to enact this ordinance for the purposes of annexing into the city limits the property more particularly set forth in this ordinance.

#### BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, KENTUCKY:

Section (1): That the City of Columbia, Kentucky, does hereby extend the corporate limits of the City of Columbia, Kentucky, as now established, so as to embrace that portion of the hereinafter described territory which is not already included within the city limits of the City of Columbia, said land being three (3) lots (#14; 15 & 16) on Murray Lane in Murray Subdivision and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin with cap #2640 on the northeast right of way of Murray Lane and S 11° 41' 00" E 159.85 feet from the southwest corner of Yarberry's house and in the line of Long Hunters Subdivision (Deed Book 98 Page 636); thence leaving Long Hunters Subdividision and along right of way, N 27° 07' 33" W 300.00 feet to a set 1/2" x 18" re-bar pin with cap #3318 and corner with John Beagan (Deed Book 227 Page 586) Lot #13; thence leaving right of way and common line with Beagan, N 61° 03' 07" E 246.00 feet to an iron pin (found) cap #2640 in the line of Murray Meadows Phase I (Plat Cabinet 2 Slide 48); thence leaving Lot #13 and with Murray Meadows Phase I, S 29° 25' 06" E 119.00 feet to a set 1/2" x 18" re-bar pin with cap #3318; thence S 22° 39' 51" E 163.39 feet to a post (deed call) witness pin (found) cap #3318 in the line of aforementioned Long Hunters Subdivision; thence leaving Murray Meadows Phase I and with Long Hunters Subdivision, S 56° 37' 57" W 239.34 feet to the point of beginning, containing 1.64 acres.

This survey is subject to any and all easements, restrictions and rights of way of record at this time. All bearing based on Magnetic North observed near the southwest property corner of Lot #16 with reference bearing N 30° E along random base line on 10/18/00.

Section (2): That the aforedescribed property which is annexed into the city limits of the City of Columbia is hereby zoned as R-1A and the Zoning Map for the City of Columbia is amended to that effect.

Section (3): That all city ordinances, orders, resolutions, motions or parts thereof insofar as same may be in conflict herewith are repealed and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.




