ORDINANCE NO. 110.37 AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND AND ENLARGE THE CORPORATE LANDS OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 110.34 the City of Columbia has enacted an ordinance setting forth the intention to annex lands and said ordinance was enacted for the purpose of complying with the statutory requirements for such an undertaking;

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia has declared it to be desirable and beneficial to annex the unincorporated territory described below and having fulfilled all statutory requirements toward that purpose and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 100.209, et seq., the Columbia Planning and Zoning Commission has followed the statutory procedure and has recommended that the subject property be classified and zoned as follows:

- 1. Annexation and map amendment for the following properties identified as Lots 10-14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21,22,23 and 30.01 and Lots 11-6,6.01, and 5 located on Campbellsville Road and Parrott Avenue. These lots are proposed to be annexed by the City of Columbia and zoned as C-2 Highway Oriented Commercial
- 2. Annexation and map amendment for the following properties identified as Lots 10-1,2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,12.01,12.02,13,24,25,26,27,28,29 and 30 and Lots 11-1,2,3,4,6.02,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15, and 16 located on Parrott Avenue. These lots are proposed to be annexed by the City of Columbia and zoned as R-2 Low Moderate Density Residential.

These properties consist of approximately 49.171 acres.

WHEREAS, the City Council has taken final action with regards to the recommendation of the Columbia Planning and Zoning Commission by enacting Ordinance No. 920.91 pursuant to which the subject property will be classified as zones listed above when it is annexed into the City of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 81A.420, et. Seq., the City of Columbia does now intend and does now annex all of the following territory to be added and to be included within the city limits, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, KENTUCKY:

Section (1): That the City of Columbia, Kentucky, does hereby extend the corporate limits of the City of Columbia, Kentucky, as now established, so as to embrace that portion of the hereinafter described territory which is not already included within the city limits of the City of Columbia, said land being 49.171 acres on northeast side of Campbellsville Road and more particularly described as follows:

Section (2): That the aforedescribed property which is annexed into the city limits of the City of Columbia is hereby zoned as R-2 Low Moderate Density Residential for Lots 10-1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9,10, 11, 12, 12.01, 12.02, 13, 24,25,26,27,28,29 and 30 and Lots 11-1,2,3,4,6.02,7,8,9,10,11,12,13,14,15, and 16 located on Parrott Avenue and C-2 Highway Oriented Commercial for Lots 10-14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20,21,22,23 and 30.01 and Lots 11-6,6.01, and 5 located on Campbellsville Road and Parrott Avenue and the zoning map has been amended to that effect.

Section (3): That all city ordinances, orders, resolutions, motions or parts thereof insofar as same may be in conflict herewith are repealed and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Our office received your submission of Annexation Ordinance 110.37 for the city of Columbia. Unfortunately we are unable to file the documents at this time.

Under the terms of KRS 81A.470, pertaining to city boundary changes, cities are required to submit an "accurate map and description of the annexed, transferred, or severed area" prepared by a professional land surveyor. The annexed parcel must close. After comparing the survey description (approved by the city in the annexation ordinance) to the plat depicting the annexed parcel, we have determined a distance call on the plat conflicts with a call in the survey description prepared by the professional land surveyor. Please have the surveyor correct the plat (or description—whichever call is in error) then resubmit the filing.

We thank you for working with us to ensure the Columbia file contains accurate information on boundary changes. Our records are copied for various agencies—some of which generate your city boundary maps. Other agencies use your filings for population estimates and urban growth projects. In order for us to provide the most accurate city information available, it is imperative all cities comply with the provisions stated in KRS 81A.470.
