## ORDINANCE NO. 2-85

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OF REAL ESTATE IN THE COUNTY OF KNOX, SAID TRACT BEING MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, the first reading of Ordinance No. 15-84 declaring an intent to annex the following described property was read and passed on October 15th, 1984, and the second reading and passage of said Ordinance was November 5th, 1984, and said Ordinance No. 15-84 was properly advertised and the residents or owners of real property within the limits of the real estate proposed to be annexed have not petitioned the Mayor in opposition to the proposed annexation, and

WHEREAS, the said real estate is contiguous to the City's present boundaries, and WHEREAS, the said real estate is suitable for development for urban purposes without unreasonable delay, and

WHEREAS, the City of Corbin, Kentucky, desires to annex the hereinafter described real estate.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS: SECTION I: The following described real estate is hereby annexed to the City of Corbin, kentucky, extending the boundaries of the City of Corbin, Kentucky, to include the same, that certain tract of real estate which is now embraced within the County of Knox and which is adjacent to and contiguous with the present City boundary line, and is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a concrete right of way marker of U. S. 25-E; thence North 40° 48' West for a distance of three hundred-one and five tenths feet (301.5') along the right of way line of U.S. 25-E to an iron stake; thence leaving the right of way line North 75° 35' east for a distance of one hundred ninety-four and three tenths feet (194.3') along an existing fence to an iron stake at a fence corner; thence South 28° 50' east for a distance of two hundred fifty-three and ninety-five tenths feet (253.95') along an existing fence line and crossing a fifteen foot wide gravel road to an iron stake in the fence line and on the right of way line of U.S. 25-E; thence south 65° 45' west for a distance of one hundred twenty-five feet (125') along the right of way line to a concrete right of way marker, the beginning point.
