AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF CORBIN A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND IN THE COUNTY OF KNOX, SAID AREA BEING OUTSIDE THE PRESENT CITY BOUNDARY AND SAID AREA BEING MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS: SECTION I. First reading of Ordinance No. 2-84 proposing the annexation of the following described property having been read on February 20th, 1984 and second reading of Ordinance No. 2-84 having been read on March 5th, 1984, and said Ordinance No. 2-84 having been properly advertised on March 8th, 1984 and the residents or freeholders of the following described property have not filed a petition in the Circuit Court of Knox County, Kentucky setting forth the reasons why the subject property should not be annexed.
