

RESOLUTION OF CORPORATION AUTHORIZING OFFICERS TO MAKE DEPOSITS AND WITHDRAWALS

I HEREBY CERTIFY that I am Secretary of the Board of Directors of Board of Commissioners of City of Corbin, Kentucky a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kentucky.

I FURTHER CERTIFY that a meeting of the Board of Directors of said Corporation was duly called and held at its office in the City of Corbin and State of Kentucky on the Sixth day of July, 1987, that at said meeting a quorum was present and voting throughout, and that the following resolutions were duly adopted and are now in full force and effect.

RESOLVED, that The First National Bank & Trust Co. of Corbin, Corbin, Kentucky, be and it is hereby designated as a depository of the funds of this Corporation, and that the said funds be subject to withdrawal upon checks, notes, drafts, bills of exchange, acceptances, undertakings or other orders for the payment of money when signed by: Mayor Tom Thurston, Mayor Pro-tem Nancy Mitchell, Treasurer Janis Tye or Deputy Treasurer Donna Malone.

RESOLVED, that above named Firm is authorized to pay any such checks, notes, drafts, bills of exchange, acceptances, undertakings or other orders and also to receive the same for the credit of or in payment from the payee or any other holder without inquiry as to the circumstances of issue or the disposition of the proceeds thereof, even if drawn to the individual order of any signing officer or payable to said Firm or others for his account, or tendered in payment of his individual obligation.

RESOLVED, that any and all endorsements for or on behalf of this Corporation upon checks, drafts, notes or instruments for deposit or collection made with the said Firm may be written or stamped endorsements of the Corporation without any designation of the person making such endorsements.

RESOLVED, that said Firm be promptly notified in writing by the Secretary or any other officer of this Corporation of any change in these resolutions or our By-Laws and that until it has actually received such notice in writing said Firm is authorized to act in pursuance of these resolutions.

I FURTHER CERTIFY that these resolutions are within the power of the Board of Directors to pass as provided in the Charter and By-Laws of this Corporation, and that the present officers of this Corporation and their respective titles are as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 13-87

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND IN THE COUNTY OF KNOX, SAID AREA BEING OUTSIDE THE PRESENT CITY BOUNDARY, AND SAID AREA BEING MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, the first reading of Ordinance No. 6-87 declaring intent to annex the following described property was read and passed on April 6, 1987, and the second reading and passage of said Ordinance was April 20th, 1987 and said Ordinance 6-87 was properly advertised and the residents or owners of real property within the limits of the real estate proposed to be annexed have not petitioned the Mayor in opposition to the proposed annexation, and

WHEREAS, the said real estate is contiguous to the City's present boundaries, and

WHEREAS, the said real estate is suitable for development for urban purposes without unreasonable delay, and

WHEREAS, the City of Corbin, Kentucky, desires to annex the hereinafter described real estate.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. The following described real estate is hereby annexed to the City of Corbin, Kentucky, extending the boundaries of the City of Corbin, Kentucky, to include the same, that certain tract of real estate which is now embraced within the County of Knox and which is adjacent to and contiguous with the present City boundary line, and is more particularly described, as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Corbin City Line; thence leaving said line North 70° 25' East to a point in the Southwest right of way line of U. S. 25E; thence with said right of way line North 54° 35' West 399 feet to a stone; thence leaving said right of way line North 73° 48' West 93 feet; thence South 12° 35' West to the Corbin City line; thence with said line to the beginning.

Section II: Immediately upon the effective date hereof the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish and advertise this Ordinance as required by Chapter 424 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes.
