ORDINANCE NO. 2779

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN BOUNDARY OF TERRITORY LYING NORTH OF THE CITY LIMITS OF CORBIN, WHITLEY COUNTY, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, The City of Corbin on the 20th day of March, 1972 passed an Ordinance proposing to annex the hereinafter described boundary of territory lying North of the City Limits of Corbin, Whitley County, Kentucky, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance was published in accordance with KRS Chapter 424 and,

WHEREAS, no action has been filed with the Whitley Circuit Court protesting said annexation, and

WHEREAS, the owners of property in said hereinafter described territory requested said annexation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the hereinafter described boundary of land or territory be and the same is hereby annexed to the city limits of Corbin. Said boundary of land or territory is described as follows;

BEGINNING at a concrete, Ky. State Highway R/W Monument. Said Monument being in the North R/W line of Ky. State road No. 312 and also being in the West line of Alabama Avenue; thence leaving the West line of Alabama Avenue, N 69 degrees 30 minutes W, with the North R/W line of said State road, 412.5 ft. to a stake, said stake being in the North R/W line of said State road and also being in the East line of a road; thence leaving the North R/W line of said State road, N 22 degrees 30 minutes E, with the East line of said road, 1687.0 ft. to a stake, a corner common to Henry Rogers; thence leaving the East line of said road, S 75 degrees 00 minutes E, with a line of Henry Rogers, part way with a fence line, 1033.0 ft. to a fence post on the East side of Spring Branch, said post being a corner common to Henry Rogers and Henry Carver; thence leaving the lines of said Rogers, with the lines of Henry Carver, up Spring Branch, with a fence line, S 45 degrees 00 minutes W - 177.8 ft. to a fence post; thence S 63 degrees 15 minutes W. 113.7 ft. to a fence post; thence S 45 degrees 45 minutes W - 272.3 ft. to a fence post; thence S 31 degrees 30 minutes W - 196.0 ft. to a fence post; thence S 9 degrees 00 minutes W, leaving the lines of Henry Carver at approximately 230 ft. and continuing with the lines of Avery Evans, in all 415.8 ft. to a fence post; thence S 16 degrees 00 minutes W, leaving the lines of Avery Evans at approximately 42 ft. and continuing with a line of Carl Tye, in all 340.0 ft to a fence post at Spring Branch, Said post also being in the North line of Jewell Street; thence leaving the lines of Carl Tye, N 70 degrees 00 minutes W, with the North line of Jewell Street - 369.0 ft. to a stake in the fence line, being the North line of Jewell Street and also being a corner common to Lydia Owens; thence leaving the North line of Jewell Street, N 14 degrees 00 minutes E, with the lines of Lydia Owens, 87.0 ft. to a stake; thence N 70 degrees 00 minutes W - 125.0 ft. to a stake in the East line of a road, Said road continuing North from the North end of Alabama Avenue. Said stake also being a corner common to Lydia Owens; thence leaving the lines of said Owens N 62 degrees 22 minutes W, across of said road, 34.2 ft. to a stake in the West line of said road; thence with the West line of said road and Alabama Avenue S 13 degrees 00 minutes W - 444.8 ft. to the beginning corner, containing 29.3 Acres.
