AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CORBIN,
KENTUCKY, ANNEXING TO THE CITY LIMITS
OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TRACTS
OF REAL PROPERTY AND ESTABLISHING THE
ZONING CLASSIFICATION FOR SAID TRACTS
OF REAL PROPERTY, OWNED BY TERRY E. FORCHT
AND NELDA L. BARTON-COLLINS; SOUTH CORBIN
DEVELOPMENT, LTD; AND SCOTT ROADEN AND
AUDRIA ROADEN, AND SAID TRACTS OF
PROPERTY BEING LOCATED ALONG BACON CREEK ROAD
AND U.S. HIGHWAY 25W/CUMBERLAND FALLS
HIGHWAY IN WHITLEY COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

WHEREAS, the owners of record of certain tracts of real property in Whitley County, Kentucky, namely, Terry E. Forcht and Nelda L. Barton-Collins; South Corbin Development, LTD; and Scott Roaden and Audria Roaden, have petitioned in writing to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Corbin, Kentucky, that their certain tracts of real property located along Bacon Creek Road and U.S. Highway 25W/Cumberland Falls Highway in Whitley County, Kentucky, be annexed and incorporated into the City of Corbin, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, said certain tracts of real property are adjacent and contiguous to the present City of Corbin, Kentucky, boundaries; and

WHEREAS, said certain tracts of real property are suitable for development for urban purposes; and

WHEREAS, said certain tracts of real property meet the criteria set forth in KRS 81A.410.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Corbin, Kentucky, as follows:

SECTION ONE. That pursuant to KRS 81A.412 those certain tracts of real property owned by Terry E. Forcht and Nelda L. Barton-Collins; South Corbin Development, LTD; and Scott Roaden and Audria Roaden, being located along Bacon Creek Road and U.S. Highway 25W/Cumberland Falls Highway in Whitley County, Kentucky, are hereby annexed to the City of Corbin, Kentucky, and said tracts of real property being more particularly described as follows:

TRACT I

BEGINNING at a 20" Black Oak, Corner No. 5 of the Philpot Estates and a corner of the Mills property, said identified with an iron stake with #15; thence with the line of the Philpot Estates, N. 58 degrees 35 minutes 00 seconds E., 425.00 feet to an iron stake #147 in said line; thence leaving the outside line of the Philpot Estate, S. 12 degrees 38 minutes 37 seconds E., 414.00 feet to an iron stake #164; thence S. 30 degrees 31 minutes 23 seconds E., 475.46 feet to an iron stake #124; thence S. 34 degrees 33 minutes 43 seconds W., 221.04 feet to an iron stake #123; thence N. 74 degrees 00 minutes 34 seconds W., 529.90 feet to an iron stake #6; thence N. 05 degrees 27 minutes 26 seconds W., 630.91 feet to the BEGINNING CORNER, containing 9.413 acres.

UTILITY EASEMENT: Also conveyed unto the grantees, their heirs and assigns, is a twenty foot wide permanent utility easement commencing at the 20" black oak (corner No. 5 of the Philpot Estate) and running generally northwest along the Philpot\Mills boundary line approximately 741.99 feet to the 34" poplar (corner No. 2 of the Philpot Estate).

ROAD EASEMENT: Also conveyed unto the grantees, their heirs and assigns, is a thirty foot wide permanent roadway easement commencing at a stake near the creek, thence continuing generally in a easterly direction with the creek (now straightened) to the above described property. This permanent roadway easement is for the common use and benefit of the grantees, their heirs and assigns, and the other adjoining landowners.

SECTION TWO. That the above-described property in SECTION ONE above owned by Terry E. Forcht and Nelda L. Barton-Collins is hereby zoned General Business District (C-1).

SECTION THREE. That the above-described property in SECTION ONE above owned by South Corbin Development, LTD, is hereby zoned General Business District (C-1).

SECTION FOUR. That the above-described property in SECTION ONE above owned by Scott Roaden and Audria Roaden is hereby zoned Residential/Rural District (R/R).

SECTION FIVE. That the Zoning Map of the City of Corbin, Kentucky, is hereby amended to add the above-described tracts of real property in SECTION ONE above, to the City of Corbin,

Kentucky, boundaries and to reflect the zoning classification given to said tracts of real property as set forth in SECTION TWO, SECTION THREE and SECTION FOUR above.

SECTION SIX. This Ordinance includes a map showing the zoning classifications given to the above-referenced tracts of real property annexed and zoned herein. Said map is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" and is hereby incorporated herein by reference. This Ordinance and the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" can be reviewed and inspected at the office of the City Clerk of the City of Corbin, Kentucky, City Hall, 805 South Main Street, Corbin, Kentucky 40701, Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m., until 4:00 p.m.

SECTION SEVEN. This Ordinance shall take effect upon two (2) readings, passage, and advertisement.

SECTION EIGHT. All ordinances or portions thereof in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
