

1973, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE ADVERTISING AND SALE OF A FRANCHISE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A COMMUNITY TELEVISION ANTENNA SYSTEM; ENUMERATING TERMS AND CONDITIONS; DECLARING EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Ordinance Number 2805, adopted on November 5, 1973, by the Board of Commissioners to the City of Corbin, Kentucky, be and the same is hereby amended so that numerical paragraph 7 (N) on page 537-FF, in Ordinance Book Number 18 thereof, is deleted and that a new paragraph 7 (N) is created as follows:

"7 (N) That the rate which the franchise charges subscribers shall be THIRTY THREE AND 75/100 (\$33.75) DOLLARS for regular installation of equipment and SEVEN AND 75/100 (\$7.75) DOLLARS per month for regular subscriber services, such rates to become effective when two (2) channels are added to existing service. No changes in rates charged to subscribers shall be made except as authorized by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Corbin, Kentucky, after an appropriate public proceeding affording due process.

ORDINANCE NO. 38-78

* AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN BOUNDARY OF TERRITORY LYING CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY LIMITS OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, The City of Corbin on the 16th day of May, 1978, passed an Ordinance proposing to annex the hereinafter described boundary of territory lying contiguous to the City Limits of Corbin, Kentucky, and,

WHEREAS, said ordinance was published in accordance with K. R. S. Chapter 424, and,

WHEREAS, no action has been filed with the Whitley Circuit Court protesting said annexation, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the hereinafter described boundary of land or territory be and the

same is hereby annexed to the City Limits of Corbin. Said boundary or territory is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a hub by a power pole at New's corner, being existing City Limits; thence S 6° 35' E. 100 feet to a stone marker; thence N. 86° 35' E. 68 feet to a steel pipe; thence S. 6° 35' E. 300 feet to an iron pipe, Winchester's corner; thence S. 86° 25' W. 334 feet to an iron pipe in a fence row; thence S. 7° 30' W. 215 feet to a concrete marker; thence S. 13 1/2° W. 146 feet to a fallen white oak; thence S. 25 1/4° E. 575 feet to a steel axle, Ellison's corner; thence S. 37° W., 125 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 25 1/2° E. 406 feet to a stone on 5th Street; thence S. 77 1/2° W. 141.5 feet to a stone on 5th Street; thence N 13° 50' W. 327 feet to a steel pipe; thence S. 32° 25' W. 87 feet to a concrete marker; thence N. 3 1/2° E. 151 feet to a stone; thence N. 88° W. 158 feet to a stone in fence; thence N. 36° W. 267 feet to a fence post; thence N. 67° W. 110 feet to a corner fence; thence S. 16° W. 405 feet to a black oak stump and dogwood at a three way fence corner; thence N. 29° W. 438 feet to a stake at the I-75 fence; thence N. 13 1/4° E. 394 feet to a steel pin in the I-75 fence; thence N. 85 1/2° E. 187 feet to a stake; thence N. 76 1/2° E. 79 feet to a stake; thence N. 82° E. 159 feet to a pin, City of Corbin corner; thence N. 24° W. 405 feet to a white oak in fence; thence N. 54° 35' E. 561.5 feet to a stake in the right of way of a 30 foot public road; thence with the right of way of said 30 foot public road, N. 86° 35' E. 192 feet to the BEGINNING.


There is also conveyed a permanent sewer easement 5 feet either side of the following line:

ORDINANCE NO. 39-78

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A CERTAIN BOUNDARY OF TERRITORY LYING CONTIGUOUS TO THE CITY LIMITS OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, The City of Corbin on the 5th day of September, 1978, passed an Ordinance proposing to annex the hereinafter described boundary of territory lying contiguous to the City Limits of Corbin, Kentucky, and,

WHEREAS, said ordinance was published in accordance with K.R.S. Chapter 424, and,

WHEREAS, no action has been filed with the Whitley Circuit Court protesting said annexation, and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CORBIN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That the hereinafter described boundary of land or territory be and the same is hereby annexed to the City Limits of Corbin. Said boundary or territory is described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake corner of Kenneth C. Bunch property; thence in a southwardly direction 124 feet with the line of Kenneth C. Bunch property to a stake a corner with Kenneth C. Bunch property; thence in an eastwardly direction 150 feet with the line of Kenneth C. Bunch property to a stake a corner of Kenneth C. Bunch property; thence in a northwardly direction, 70 feet with line of Kenneth C. Bunch property; thence in a westwardly direction 124 feet with the line of Kenneth C. Bunch property and the Bolton Hill Road to a stake at the BEGINNING.
