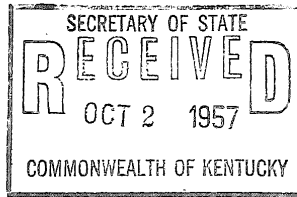

JUDGMENT

THIS CAUSE BEING SUBMITTED FOR JUDGMENT AND IT APPEARING THAT MORE THAN TWO-THIRDS OF THE VOTERS RESIDING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE AREA HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED AND WHICH IS PROPOSED TO BE INCORPORATED, AND THAT MORE THAN SIX HUNDRED INHABITANTS RESIDE THEREIN, AND IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT THE PETITION TO INCORPORATE HAS BEEN DULY ADVERTISED AS REQUIRED BY LAW AND THERE BEING NO OBJECTION INTERPOSED THERETO:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT THE TERRITORY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED BE AND THE SAME IS HEREBY INCORPORATED AS A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE SIXTH CLASS TO BE NAMED AND KNOWN AS THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY. SUCH AREA IS DESCRIBED BY HERES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTER LINES OF BUTTERMILK PIKE AND THE SOUTHERN RAILROAD; THENCE S. 49° W. A DISTANCE OF 4385 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE N. 41° W A DISTANCE OF 2640 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE N. 49° E. A DISTANCE OF 2640 FEET TO A POINT; THENCE S. 41° E. A DISTANCE OF 2640 FEET TO A POINT IN ANDERSON ROAD; THENCE S. 49° W. A DISTANCE OF 1255 FEET TO THE PLACE OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING ONE-QUARTER SQUARE MILE IN AREA.

THE COURT BEING FURTHER ADVISED THAT BY AN AGREEMENT OF THE PETITIONERS, THE FOLLOWING PERSONS ARE

HEREBY APPOINTED TO SERVE IN THE CAPACITIES DESIGNATED
UNTIL THEIR SUCCESSORS ARE DULY ELECTED AND QUALIFIED:


