

ORDINANCE NO. 1980-47

AN ORDINANCE DE-ANNEXING AND REDUCING THE BOUNDARY OF A PART OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY, A CITY OF THE FIFTH CLASS PURSUANT TO THE KENTUCKY REVISED STATUTES.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CRESCENT SPRINGS, KENTUCKY DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

The City Council of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky enacted Ordinance No. 1980-41, an ordinance proposing and intending to de-annex a part of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky.

SECTION II

That pursuant to the Kentucky Revised Statutes Ordinance 1980-41 was duly published and pursuant to said statutes the question of de-annexation and reduction of the municipal boundaries of said City was submitted to the qualified voters of the portion therein described in Ordinance No. 1980-41 and that at the regular election held on November 4, 1980 the following question of de-annexation was put to said qualified voters as follows:
"Are you in favor of de-annexing from the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky?"

SECTION III

Pursuant to said general election conducted as stated above, the qualified voters approved the question as stated above by a vote of 21 Yes and 5 votes No. The Clerk

of Kenton County, Kentucky has certified to the City of Crescent Springs the results as specified herein. A copy of said Board of Election Certification is enclosed herein and incorporated herein by reference as if fully set forth.

SECTION IV

That pursuant to said election results as specified hereinabove, the City Council of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky hereby de-annexes and reduces from the municipal corporate boundaries of said City a portion of said City as particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the present corporate boundary of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky, said point being in the easterly line of a 50 foot wide passway to Crest Mobile Home Park, said passway being known as Crest Drive; said point being 233 feet, more or less, southeasterly along said easterly line from the centerline of Anderson Road; thence with the said corporation line N 44°-15' E, a distance of approximately 344 feet, more or less, to a corner of the International Villages property; thence continuing along the said corporation line and International Villages line, N 43°-59' E, said line being the same line described as bearing N 44°-15' E., in the annexation description, a distance of 210.00 feet to a corner of said International Villages tract; thence along said International Village line, S 45°-33' E, 95.81 feet to a point; thence N 87°-25' E, 112.53 feet to a point; thence S 33°-50' W, 238.36 feet to a point; thence N 45°-45' W, 20.00 feet to a point; thence S 44°-15' W, 319.00 feet to a point; thence along a curve to the right, said curve having a radius of 80.00 feet and an arc distance of 125.60 feet to a point in the easterly line of a 50 foot wide passway, known as Crest Drive; thence along said easterly line, N 45°-45' W, a distance of approximately 117.5 feet to the point of beginning.

The intent of the above description is to include any and all of the parcel of land known as the International Villages that lies within the corporate limits of the City of Crescent Springs, Kentucky as it presently exists.

SECTION V

That this ordinance is passed pursuant to the applicable Kentucky Revised Statute and particularly K.R.S. Chapter 81A.

SECTION VI

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage, publication and recording according to law.
