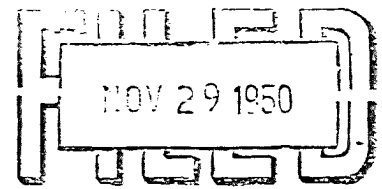

ORDER

This matter having been submitted on the petition of more than a majority of the registered voters residing within the hereinafter described area, and it appearing that proper notice has been given by publication, and no defense having been interposed:

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the following described territory be and is hereby established as a city of the sixth class with all the powers and authorities authorized by the constitution and laws of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, and to be known as the CITY OF CRESTVIEW:

Situated in Campbell County, State of Kentucky and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on rightaway intersection of Uhl Road and Dodsworth Lane (this point being fifteen (15) feet and 0 inches northwest of center of Uhl Road and fifteen (15) feet and 0 inches southeast of Dodsworth Lane, running thence north  $58^{\circ} 30'$  east three hundred (300) feet, (this line being parallel to and fifteen (15) feet and 0 inches from center of Dodsworth Lane); thence along Dodsworth Lane north  $59^{\circ} 20'$  east two hundred twenty-five (225) feet to a hub; thence north  $55^{\circ} 30'$  east one hundred fifty (150) feet; thence leaving Dodsworth Lane and running fifteen (15) feet from and parallel to Sky Line Drive north  $45^{\circ} 30'$  east a distance of three hundred (300) feet; thence north  $32^{\circ} 30'$  east three hundred (300) feet; thence north  $5^{\circ} 0'$  east fifty-six (56) feet to a hub; thence leaving rightaway of Sky Line Drive south  $78^{\circ} 20'$  east a distance of 176.8 feet to a hub; thence south  $63^{\circ} 25'$  east one thousand six hundred fifty-two (1652) and five tenths feet to a point; thence south  $3^{\circ} 30'$  west one hundred seventy-nine and five tenths (179.5) feet; thence south  $29^{\circ} 15'$  east a distance of one hundred two and five tenths (102.5) feet to a point; thence south  $11^{\circ} 04'$  west a distance of one hundred fifty-eight (158) feet; thence south  $78^{\circ} 45'$  west eighteen hundred twenty (1820) feet to a hub of rightaway of Uhl Road, (this point being fifteen (15) feet from center of Uhl Road); thence north  $50^{\circ} 10'$  west along Uhl Road and fifteen (15) feet from center line, a distance of one thousand ninety-nine and five tenths (1999.5) feet to the point of beginning.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that William T. Toner, Blaine Marz, Charles Raming, Wilbur Lancaster, and Edward Storer be and they are hereby appointed as Trustees of said City of Crestview, to hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities may be elected and until their successors qualify, and

that Doctor H. W. Kaurish be and is hereby appointed Police Judge of said City, to hold that office until the next election at which officers for cities may be elected and until his successor qualifies, and

that Walter Ashmore be and is hereby appointed Marshall of said City, to hold that office until the next election at which officers for cities may be elected and until his successor qualifies, and

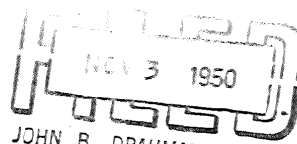
that Erwin Smith be and is hereby appointed assessor for said City, to hold that office until the next election at which officers for cities may be elected and until his successor qualifies.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court be and is hereby ordered to certify, forthwith, a copy of this order to the Secretary of State at Frankfort, Kentucky who shall properly index and file the same as a permanent record in his office.

PETITION

IN RE:  
INCORPORATION OF CITY OF CRESTVIEW  
CAMPBELL COUNTY, KENTUCKY

The undersigned petitioners, by affixing their signatures hereto, certify that they and each of them are registered resident voters of the territory hereinafter described and proposed to be established as a city and that they constitute two-thirds of the voters living within the boundries of said territory; that the boundry of said territory does not exceed one-half mile in each direction, the form of same being nearly square, and an estimated 480 inhabitants reside within said boundry, as of the date shown in the affidivit hereto attached.

Petitioners further state that heretofore Vetvillage Home Builders Association, Inc. has supplied water, repaired and maintained its streets and has furnished all other services which are governmental in nature; that said corporation is now in the process of dissolution and will no-longer perform said services.

Petitioners further states that said territory and they as citizens, residents and voters thereof require a means by which they can provide themselves and said territory with a means to maintain streets, to provide street lighting, waste and garbage collection and disposal, police protection and for the orderly adminiatration and operation of said territory as a legally established municipality as authorised under the provisions of Kentucky Revised Statutes 81.040 et seq.

Petitioners state that they desire said territory, when incorporated, to be named "The City of Crestview"; that there are 130 voters residing within

the territory proposed to be incorporated and said territory is described as follows:

Situated in Campbell County, State of Kentucky, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning on rightway intersection of Uhl Road and Dodsworth Lane, (this point being fifteen (15) feet and 0 inches Northwest of center of Uhl Road and fifteen (15) feet and 0 inches Southeast of Dodsworth Lane), running thence North  $58^{\circ} 30'$  East three hundred (300) feet, (this line being parallel to and fifteen (15) feet 0 inches from center of Dodsworth Lane); thence along Dodsworth Lane North  $59^{\circ} 20'$  East two hundred twenty-five (225) feet to a hub; thence North  $55^{\circ} 30'$  East one hundred-fifty (150) feet; thence leaving Dodsworth Lane and running fifteen (15) feet from and parallel to Skyline Drive North  $45^{\circ} 30'$  East a distance of three hundred (300) feet; thence North  $32^{\circ} 30'$  East 300 feet; thence North  $5^{\circ} 0'$  East fifty-six (56) feet to a hub; thence leaving rightway of Skyline Drive South  $78^{\circ} 20'$  East a distance of 176.8 feet to a hub; thence South  $63^{\circ} 25'$  East one thousand six hundred fifty-two and five-tenths (1652.5) feet to a point; thence South  $3^{\circ} 30'$  West one hundred seventy-nine and five-tenths (179.5) feet; thence South  $29^{\circ} 15'$  East a distance of one hundred two and five-tenths (102.5) feet to a point; thence South  $11^{\circ} 04'$  West a distance of one hundred fifty-eight (158) feet; thence South  $78^{\circ} 45'$  West eighteen hundred twenty (1820) feet to a hub of rightaway of Uhl Road, (this point being fifteen (15) feet from center line of Uhl Road); thence North  $50^{\circ} 10'$  West along Uhl Road and fifteen (15) feet from Center Line, a distance of one thousand ninety-nine and five-tenths (1099.5) feet to the point of beginning.

Petitioners further state that said territory requires  
proper administrative officers and that it is necessary  
that the Court appoint a Police Judge, a Marshall, a City  
Assessor and five Trustees to hold office until the next  
election at which officers for said City may be elected.

WHEREFORE, petitioners pray that this Court  
enter a judgement and order establishing the territory  
herein described as a City, to be known as the City of  
"Crestview", for appointment of a Police Judge, Marshall,  
Assessor and five Trustees as officers of said City, to  
hold their respective office until the next election; to  
invest said City with all the powers and authorities  
authorised by law, and for all such further orders and  
general relief to which petitioners may be entitled.
