## COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY CITY OF CRESTWOOD ORDINANCE NO. 13, SERIES 2000

SUBJECT: AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CONTIGUOUS PROPERTY TO THE CITY OF CRESTWOOD, KENTUCKY, BEING A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND LOCATED IN OLDHAM COUNTY, KENTUCKY, MORE PARTICULARLY HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF CRESTWOOD, KENTUCKY, THAT:

SECTION ONE: The following territory lying contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Crestwood, Oldham County, Kentucky shall be annexed into the City of Crestwood, Kentucky in accordance with KRS 81A.410 to 81A.470 and other applicable laws, rules and regulations. Said tract of land is now within the county of Oldham and is adjacent to and contiguous to the present City boundaries and is not located in any other incorporated area and is described as follows:

SEE ATTACHED DESCRIPTION.

SECTION TWO: The Board of Commissioners hereby finds that the annexation criteria set forth in KRS 81A.410 (1) exist and that no part of the territory to be annexed is presently within the boundaries of an incorporated city.

SECTION THREE: The City Commissioners of the City of Crestwood, Kentucky, further find that all property owners of record within the territory proposed to be annexed have either consented to the annexation or filed no objections or remonstrants in the manner prescribed by the Kentucky Revised Statutes within sixty (60) days from the date of the enactment of the Ordinance proposing to annex the hereinabove described territory.

SECTION FOUR: Immediately upon the effective date hereof, the Clerk of the City of Crestwood is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance in the Oldham Era in the absence of a daily or weekly newspaper published within the boundaries of the City of Crestwood.

SECTION FIVE: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication.


