ORDINANCE NO. 3-77

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED TERRITORIES TO THE CITY OF CRITTENDEN, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 81 OF THE KENTUCKY REVISED STATUTES

Whereas by ordinance No. 2-77 the city proposed the annexation of the herein after described lands and published same in the Grant County News in the May 26, 1977 issue.

Whereas, more than thirty days have passed and no protest nor objection has been filed to said proposed annexation.

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF CRITTENDEN, GRANT COUNTY, KENTUCKY, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the herein-after described properties are annexed and made a part of the City of Crittenden, Grant County, Kentucky.

SECTION II

Lying and being in Grant County, Kentucky and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on Violet Road, also known as Kentucky Highway 1548, at its intersection with the centerline of Kentucky 2363; thence with the centerline of 2363 and encompassing the right-of-way of said road in a general northerly direction a distance of 300 feet, or a sufficient number of feet to reach a parcel of ground lying and being on the west side of Kentucky Route 2363 (Child Welfare Center Road) 0.5 miles north of Violet Road in Grant County, Kentucky and more particularly described as follows;

A parcel of ground lying and being on the West side of the Kentucky Route 2363 (Child Welfare Center Road) 0.05 miles North of Violet Road in Grant County, Kentucky and more particularly described as follows;

Beginning at a spike in the center of Kentucky Route 2363 and a corner to a 1.50 acre tract conveyed by Dodson Turner to Eula Mae Phillips; thence leaving said road and with the lines of said 1.50 acre tract, N 89° 45' W--400.0 feet to a stake; thence S 5° 08' W--213.7 feet to a stake in the back line of the Archie Coldiron Subdivision; thence with said line S 76° 49' W--821.6 feet to a post a corner to Archie Coldiron; thence with Coldiron's lines, N 39° 10' W--1124.5 feet to a post on the South side of a hollow; thence N 50° 58' E--841.7 feet to a post; thence N 52° 13' E--609.5 feet to a post; thence N 37° 04' W--369.2 feet to a 14" Walnut; thence N 11° 40' W--398.4 feet to a 8" Walnut; thence N 4° 29' W--477.8 feet to a 8" Elm on the South side of Bullock Pen Creek and in the line of W.F. Courtney; thence with Courtney's line, N 78° 10' E--66.3 feet to a 24" Walnut; thence S 57° 10' E--45.2 feet to a 30" Elm; thence with the center of Bullock Pen Creek, N 62° 15' E--378.2 feet thence N 88° 20' E--138.0 feet; thence S 78° 40' E--156.6 feet; thence N 70° 21' E--122.5 feet; thence S 21° 55' E--122.5 feet; thence S 8° 01' E--101.4 feet thence S 32° 07' E--212.9 feet; thence S 54° 26' E--127.6 feet thence N 71° 05' E--90.4 feet to a point in the center of a bridge and the center of an old county road; thence with the center of the county road, S 3° 37' E--40.1 feet; thence S 10° 00' W--219.4 feet; thence S 1° 08' W--113.1 feet; thence S 5° 36' E--171.5 feet; thence S 15° 39' E--106.5 feet to a P.K. Nail in the center of Kentucky Route

2363; thence with the center of said road, S 00 36' W-- 437.0 feet; thence S 1° 31' W--100.0 feet; thence S 3° 12' W--100.0 feet; thence S 5° 46' W--100.0feet; thence S 7° 16' W--523.6 feet; thence S 6° 01' W--374.4 feet to the place of beginning containing 88.51 acres, more or less, exclusive of all easement and legal right of ways of record.

The above description is in accordance with a survey made by Hicks & Mann, Inc. on the 3rd day of May, 1976.

This being the same land conveyed by general warranty deed of Dodson Turner, et ux to Phillip G. Hicks and Kay Hicks, his wife, et al of date May 24, 1976 same appearing of record in the Grant County Court Clerk's Office in deed book 126, page 510.

That this Ordinance is enacted pursuant to the authority contained in Chapter 81 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes and same is hereby ordered published in one issue of the Grant County News, a newspaper of general circulation in Grant County, Kentucky.
