ORDINANCE NO. 1144

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN LAND ADJACENT TO THE CITY OF CYNTHIANA, KENTUCKY, AND LYING GENERALLY SOUTH OF SAID CITY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Cynthiana, Kentucky recognizes the importance of orderly urban growth in preserving and expanding the benefits of municipal government for all citizens, and

WHEREAS, the City of Cynthiana recognizes the likelihood, potential and trend of urban development in the area bounded by U.S. 27 lying south and west of the present boundaries of the City, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable for all concerned that said urban growth and development occur within expanded limits of the City of Cynthiana, and

WHEREAS, the City is willing and able to extend municipal sanitary sewer facilities to the annexed area to insure the safe and healthful disposal of waste in said area of potential growth, and

WHEREAS, an Agreement has been reached between the City of Cynthiana and Covington Food Services, Inc., whereby the owners of said property have agreed to compensate and reimburse the City of Cynthiana for all costs incurred in engineering and construction of an extension of a sewer line to the subject property, which Agreement is incorporated by reference herein, and

WHEREAS, all owners and residents of the subject property, including the Commonwealth of Kentucky, have executed sworn verified consents, copies of which are attached hereto, thereby waiving their rights to, remonstrate or object as per the provisions of KRS 81A.420;

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City of Cynthiana,

Kentucky:

Section 1: That the City of Cynthiana, Kentucky hereby does extend its boundaries and annex property contiguous to the City as shown in Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein and that said property shall henceforth be a part of the City of Cynthiana for all purposes, and that said property is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a Sycamore, corner to Dillie; thence S. 10 E. $31\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a stone corner to same; thence $48\frac{1}{2}$ E. 28 poles to a stone in North margin of the Leesburg Pike; thence N. 36 3/4 E. 67.44 poles to a stone in same; thence N. $36\frac{1}{4}$ 71.38 poles to a stone in hedge corner to Renaker; thence N. 62 3/4 W. 5.3 poles to a stone in same; thence N. 86 3/4 W. 27.9 poles to a stone corner to same; then ce N. 69½ W. 15.16 poles to a gate post corner to same; thence S. 16½ W. 57.06 poles to a fence post corner to same; thence S. 3 E. $14\frac{1}{2}$ poles to stone, corner to same; thence S. $22\frac{1}{2}$ E. 8.94 poles to a stone corner to same in Dillie line; thence N. 55 E. 2 poles to stone to Dillie; thence S. $72\frac{1}{4}$ E. 25 poles to a stone corner to same; thence S. $4\frac{1}{2}$ W. $4\frac{1}{2}$ poles to a stone corner to same; thence N. $80\frac{1}{4}$ E. $36\frac{3}{4}$ poles to a stone corner to same; thence N. $31\frac{3}{4}$ E. $28\frac{1}{4}$ poles to a Sycamore corner to same; thence S. 77½ E. 18 poles to the beginning, containing 71 acres of land, more or less.

This legal description was derived before U.S. 27 was constructed and it is the intent of the City of Cynthiana, through this annexation, to include in said annexation the western (northbound) half of U.S. 27, including and subject to its right of way, in such an amount and length as is bounded by Northern and Southern boundaries of the above-described property that are adjacent to or "front" said property.

Section 2: The copies of the map and plat showing the above boundaries are to be filed with the Cynthiana City Clerk and the Clerk of the Harrison County Court.

· Section 3: That this ordinance pertaining to the annexation of the above described property be published in the Cynthiana Democrat, the newspaper with the largest circulation published in

Harrison County, and by the City Clerk, to meet the requirements of K.R.S. Chapter 424.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect from and after its approval, passage and publication as required by law.
