

ORDINANCE NO. 1182

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF CYNTHIANA, KENTUCKY, ANNEXING CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS PROPERTY TO THE CITY, LYING NORTH OF PIKE STREET AND EAST OF ELMARCH AVENUE AND BEING SURROUNDED ON ALL SIDES BY PROPERTY CURRENTLY WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CYNTHIANA.

WHEREAS the City Commission of the City of Cynthiana, Kentucky recognizes the importance of orderly urban growth in perserving and expanding the benefits of municipal government for all citizens; and,

WHEREAS the City recognizes the potential for growth of residential development in the area of Pike Street and Elmarch Avenue; and,

WHEREAS, municipal water and sewer facilities are located near the annexed area to insure safe and healthful disposal of waste in the area of potential and actual development with the owners of the annexed property to bear the cost of extending such facilities to the subject property, if desirable, and obtaining necessary permits, easements and approvals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF CYNTHIANA, KENTUCKY:

SECTION 1. That the City of Cynthiana, Kentucky hereby extends its boundaries and annexes contiguous property to the City as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and that said property shall henceforth be a part of the City of Cynthiana for all purposes.

SECTION 2: That a copy of the map and plat showing the above boundaries is to be filed with the Cynthiana City Clerk and the Clerk of the Harrison County Court, respectively.

SECTION 3: That this Ordinance pertaining to the annexation of the above-described property by being published in the Cynthiana Democrat, the newspaper with the largest circulation in Harrison County, by the City Clerk, to meet the requirements of KRS Chapter 424.


SECTION 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
