

JUDGMENT

WHEREAS, Ronald Young, Melvin Forman and Philip Onkotz and 194 other petitioners have filed a petition to incorporate a city to be known as Douglass Hills No.1, Kentucky, pursuant to the provisions of KRS 81.040, 81.050 and 81.060, and

WHEREAS, the boundary of the proposed city does not exceed one-half mile in each direction, the form of the city being square and containing in excess of 125 inhabitants, and

WHEREAS, at least two-thirds of the voters living within the boundary of the proposed city have petitioned for its incorporation, and

WHEREAS, notice of the filing of the petition and of its object has been given by publication pursuant to KRS Chapter 424, and the Court being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT

1. The following described property situated in Jefferson County, Kentucky, be and hereby is incorporated into a city bearing the name of Douglass Hills No. 1, Kentucky.

Beginning at the Northeast corner of lot 285 of Douglass Hills Subdivision Section 4, as recorded in plat book 25, page 57, in the office of the County Clerk, Jefferson County, Kentucky; said point being on the West side of the Louisville Gas and Electric high tension line easement as shown on the above mentioned plat; thence in a Westerly direction at an angle of ninety degrees from the previously described Louisville Gas and Electric easement line a distance of 2,400 feet to the true point of beginning, said point being approximately 250 feet North of the intersection of Oraemoor Place and Gatehouse Lane; thence in a Southernly direction at an angle of ninety degrees from the previously described boundary line a distance of 620 feet to a point, said point being approximately 350 feet South of the intersection of Oraemoor Place and Gatehouse Lane; thence in a Westerly direction at an angle of ninety degrees from the previously described boundary line a distance of 1,940 feet to a point, said point being approximately 600 feet

South of the intersection of Moser Road and Tattenham Lane; thence in a Northernly direction at an angle of ninety degrees from the previously described boundary line a distance of 1,940 feet to a point, said point, being approximately 400 feet North of the intersection of Moser Road and Chertsey Place; thence in an Easterly direction at an angle of ninety degrees from the previously described boundary line a distance of 1,940 feet to a point, said point being approximately 100 feet Southwest of the intersection of Burnsdale Road and Sunderland Road; thence in a Southernly direction at an angle of ninety degrees from the previously described boundary line a distance of 1,320 feet to the true point of beginning containing approximately 86.4 acres.

2. Pursuant to the desire of the petitioners and KRS 81.060, the following qualified voters within the incorporated area be and hereby are appointed to hold the following offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected:

Trustees: Ronald Young, Philip Onkotz, Rosemary Riley, Ann Bauer and Stephen P. Gennett.



Marshal: John Spellman


3. The Clerk of this Court shall, not later than ten days from the date hereof, certify a copy hereof to the Secretary of State of Kentucky.
