Dear Ms. Mills:

Senate Bill 22, as enacted by the 1980 General Assembly, requires for a city to continue to be eligible for state funds, that it submit to your office no later than July 15, 1981, a report setting forth the name of the city, the year in which it was incorporated, the current classification and a map of the city's current boundaries.

The City of Douglass Hills in Jefferson County was incorporated as a sixth class city in 1973, and attained fourth class status in the 1978 session of the General Assembly. Enclosed is a map with the boundaries of our city indicated by an orange marker. We have two pending annexation proposals which will be placed on the ballot for the November election. Should we be successful in those proposals, we will file separate maps of those areas at that time.

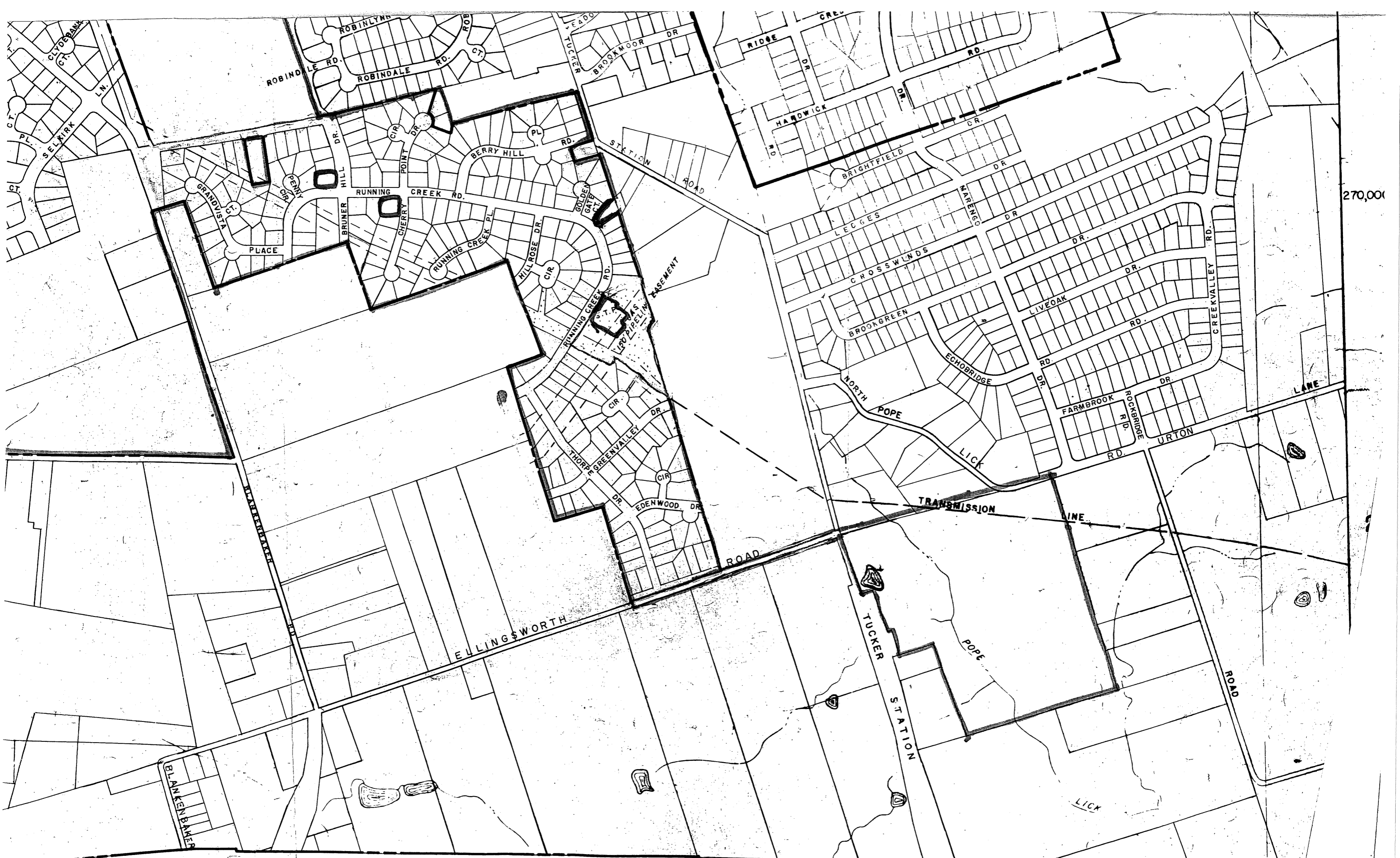
