On April 1, 1981, the Douglass Hills City Council approved Ordinance No. 5, Series 1981, "An Ordinance Annexing to the City of Douglass Hills, Kentucky, a Certain Tract of Unincorporated Territory." I am enclosing 1) an accurate map of this annexation area; 2) a certified copy of the annexation ordinance, which includes 3) a metes and bounds description of this tract of land; and 4) a municipal boundary map of the City at the time of this particular annexation. ORDINANCE NO. 5, SERIES 1981

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF DOUGLASS HILLS, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OF UNINCORPORATED TERRITORY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF DOUGLASS HILLS, KENTUCKY:

Section 1: There is hereby annexed to the City of Douglass Hills, Kentucky, and the boundaries of the City of Douglass Hills, Kentucky, are hereby extended to include the same, a certain tract of land which is more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point, said point being the southeast corner of Running Creek Estates, Section No. 5 as recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 31, Page 25, in the Office of the Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky; said point also being in the boundary line of the City of Douglass Hills as described in Ordinance No. 11, Series 1976, City of Douglass Hills and in the north line of Ellingsworth Road; thence east along the north line of Ellingsworth Road to an intersection with the east line of Tucker Station Road; thence continuing in an easterly direction to a point in the centerline of Pope Lick Road where the centerline of Pope Lick Road intersects the east line extended northerly of a tract conveyed to Douglass Hills Section 14, Inc., as recorded in Deed Book 5149, Page 230 in the Office of the Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky; thence in a southerly direction with the east line of said Douglass Hills Section 14, Inc. tract to the southeast corner of said tract; thence in a westerly direction along the southline of said Douglass Hills Section 14, Inc. tract to a corner common to the southeast corner of Klutz; thence in a northerly direction and with the east line of Klutz extended to the northeast corner of Partin; thence in a westerly direction along the north line of Partin to a point in the east right-of-way line of Tucker Station Road; thence north along the east line of Tucker Station Road to a point where the south line of Ellingsworth Road, if extended, intersects

the east line of Tucker Station Road; thence west along the south line of Ellingsworth Road to a point where west line of the before-mentioned Running Creek Estates, Section No. 5, if extended south, intersects the south line of Ellingsworth Road; thence north along the before-mentioned west line extended of Running Creek Estates, Section No. 5 to the southwest corner of said subdivision; said point also being the southwest corner of the boundary of the City of Douglass Hills, as described in Ordinance No. 11, Series 1976, City of Douglass Hills; thence in an easterly direction along the south line of Running Creek Estates, Section No. 5 and also the south boundary of the City of Douglass Hills to the point of beginning.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective when published as required by applicable statute.
