JUDGMENT

JUDGMENT

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This cause coming on to be heard, and it appearing to the Court from the records herein that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in two issues of the Louisville Times on November 1, 1949, and November 8, 1949, said newspaper being published in and of general circulation in Jefferson County, Kentucky, and it further appearing to the Court and the Court being satisfied from the verified petition herein that the population within the boundary described in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of law in such cases, and no defense having been imposed herein, it is now ordered, adjudged and decreed:

l. That a town by the name of Druid Hills be and is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class within the following described boundary, as more fully described and shown by a map filed with the petition herein, said boundary being described as follows, towit:

BEGINNING at a point in the southwest line of Druid Hills Subdivision, Section #2; said point being the northeast corner of the intersection of Napanee head and the east line of Chenoweth Lane. Thence running in a northerly direction with the east ine of Chenoweth Lane 120.73 feet to the southwest corner of Druid Hills Subdivision Section #1. Thence continuing with the east line of Chenoweth Lane and with the southwest line of Druid Hills Subdivision Section #1 in a northerly direction 541.27 feet to the southwest line of Brownsboro Village Subdivision, said point being the northeast corner of Chenoweth Lane and Fairy Drive. Thence continuing in a northerly direction with the east line of Chenoweth Lane 833.44 feet to the intersection of

the east line of Chenoweth Lane and the south line of U.S. Highway #42. Thence eastwardly along the south line of U.S. Highway #42 557.26 feet to the northeast line of Brownsboro Village Subdivision. Thence continuing eastwardly with the south line of U.S. Highway #42 to the intersection of the southwest line of Chippewa Road, if extended. The boundary line shall then run southwardly along the west line of Chippewa Road, if extended, to the northeast corner of Druid Hills Subdivision Section #1. Thence continuing in a southerly direction along the west line of Chippewa Road 899.92 feet to the northeast corner of Druid Hills Subdivision Section #2. Thence continuing in a southerly direction with the west line of Chippewa Road 144.44 feet to the intersection of the northwest line of Chippewa Road and the north line of Rapanee Road, Thence westwardly along the north line of Rapanee Road 1758.89 feet to the intersection of the northeast line of Chenoweth Lane and the north line of Maranee Road, the point of beginning."

2. That there are hereby appointed as the Board of Trustees of said town the following named persons resident therein, towit, Albert Tollefsen, Lawrence Irwin, Milton F. Jefferson, and Dan T. Gray, Jr. and Jack Small; J. W. Jones, as Folice Judge thereof, Temple Lewis, as Marshal thereof, and B. S. Markolf, as Assessor thereof. Each of said Trustees and officers shall hold their respective offices until the next General election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected and until their successors shall have been elected and qualified.

The qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law and by taking the respective oaths of office and executing the respective bonds and obligations prescribed by law which shall be entered upon the records of said town.

In accordance with Section 81.060, KRS, the Clerk of this Court is directed, not later than ten (10) days after the entry of this judgment, to certify a copy thereof to the Secretary of State at Frankfort, Kentucky.

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
