81.045. City identity documents to be filed with the secretary of state—Effect of noncompliance.—In order to update the record of incorporation of cities in the secretary of state's office, every city presently operating as a public corporation and a unit of local government shall file with the secretary of state within one (1) year from July 15, 1980 a document listing the name of the city, the year of its incorporation, the present classification and the present boundaries. If a city fails to comply with this section, it shall be barred from receiving state moneys until such time as the city complies. (Enact. Acts 1980, ch. 116, § 1, effective July 15, 1980.)

The following information is in answer to your memorandum of April 3, 1981.

NAME OF CITY: Druid Hills

DATE OF INCORPORATION: January 1950, Action#301,668 Jan. 17, 1950

PRESENT CLASSIFICATION: Sixth Class City

PRESENT BOUNDARIES: Beginning at the northeast corner at the intersection of Napanee Road, and the east line of Chenoweth Lane; running thence in a northwardly direction with the East line of Chenoweth Lane to the intersection of the East line of Chenoweth Lane and the south line of U.S. Highway 42; and thence to the intersection running eastwardly along the south line of U.S. 42 to the intersection of the southwest line of Chippewa Road, and thence running southwardly along the West line of Chippewa Road to the intersection of the northwestwardly line of Chippewa Road and the north line of Napanee Road; and thence running Westwardly along the north line of Napanee Road, to the point of beginning.
