The new boundaries indicated in the annexation will now be considered the boundaries of Ewing.

## Ordinance 02

The city of Ewing, Kentucky hereby enacts ordinance 02 annexing the following three parcels, pursuant to K.R.S. 81A.420, as expressed in the following metes and bounds:

### Parcel 1

Beginning at a point, on the original eastern corporate limits of Ewing, Kentucky at the center point of Kentucky Route 165, continuing north along the eastern corporate limits 163 feet to a point, then continuing east 1125 feet parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165 to a point then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 113 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 250 feet to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165 across Kentucky Route 165, 413 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 913 feet to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 406 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to Kentucky Route 165, 494 feet to the southeast corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing north along the original eastern corporate limits 513 feet to the centerpoint of Kentucky Route 165.

### Parcel 2

Begining at a point on the original southern corporate limits 775 feet east from the southwest corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing south 138 feet perpendicular to the southern corporate limits to a point, then continuing east 106 feet parallel to the original southern corporate limits to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to the original southern corporate limits 500 feet to the centerpoint of the TransKentucky Transportation Railroad company (TTI) tracks, then continuing northeast along the centerline of the TTI tracks 269 feet to a point then continuing east 250 feet parallel to the original southern corporate limits to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to the original southern corporate limits 50 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the original southern corporate limits 225 feet to the centerpoint of the TTI tracks, then continuing northeast along the centerline of the TTI tracks 475 feet to the original southern corporate limits 1050 feet west of the southeast corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing west along the original southern corporate limits 625 feet to a point on the original southern corporate limits, 775 feet east from the southwest corner of the original corporate limits.

Parcel 3

Beginning at a point, on the original western corporate limits, 106 feet north of the southwest corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 488 feet to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 63 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 669 feet to a point, then continuing south parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 560, 575 feet to a point, then continuing west perpendicular to the centerline of Kentucky Route 560, 150 feet to a point, then continuing north parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 560, 525 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to Kentucky Route 165, 338 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 206 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 288 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 188 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to Kentucky Route 165, 238 feet to a point then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 163 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 675 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 363 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 163 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 175 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 125 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 325 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 863 feet to a point on the original western corporate limits, 525 feet from the northwest corner of the original corporate limits of Ewing, Kentucky, then continuing south along the original western corporate limits 975 feet to a point 106 feet north of the southwest corner of the original corporate limits of Ewing, Kentucky.

The three parcels are contiguous to the current incorporated boundaries of the city of Ewing, Kentucky.

ORDINANCE 01

The city of Ewing hereby expresses its intention to annex the three parcels, pursuant to K.R.S. 81A. 420, as expressed by the following metes and bounds:

Parcel 1

Beginning at a point, on the original eastern corporate limits of Ewing, Kentucky at the center point of Kentucky Route 165, continuing north along the eastern corporate limits 163 feet to a point, then continuing east 1125 feet parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165 to a point then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 113 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 250 feet to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165 across Kentucky Route 165, 413 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 913 feet to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 406 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to Kentucky Route 165, 494 feet to the southeast corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing north along the original eastern corporate limits 513 feet to the centerpoint of Kentucky Route 165.

Parcel 2


Begining at a point on the original southern corporate limits 775 feet east from the southwest corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing south 138 feet perpendicular to the southern corporate limits to a point, then continuing east 106 feet parallel to the original southern corporate limits to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to the original southern corporate limits 500 feet to the centerpoint of the TransKentucky Transportation Railroad company (TTI) tracks, then continuing northeast along the centerline of the TTI tracks 269 feet to a point then continuing east 250 feet parallel to the original southern corporate limits to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to the original southern corporate limits 50 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the original southern corporate limits 225 feet to the centerpoint of the TTI tracks, then continuing northeast along the centerline of the TTI tracks 475 feet to the original southern corporate limits 1050 feet west of the southeast corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing west along the original southern corporate limits 625 feet to a point on the original southern corporate limits, 775 feet east from the southwest corner of the original corporate limits.

Parcel 3

Beginning at a point, on the original western corporate limits, 106 feet north of the southwest corner of the original corporate limits, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 488 feet to a point, then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 63 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 669 feet to a point, then continuing south parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 560, 575 feet to a point, then continuing west perpendicular to the centerline of Kentucky Route 560, 150 feet to a point, then continuing north parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 560, 525 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to Kentucky Route 165, 338 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 206 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 288 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 188 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to Kentucky Route 165, 238 feet to a point then continuing south perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 163 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 675 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 363 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 163 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 175 feet to a point, then continuing west parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 125 feet to a point, then continuing north perpendicular to Kentucky Route 165, 325 feet to a point, then continuing east parallel to the centerline of Kentucky Route 165, 863 feet to a point on the original western corporate limits, 525 feet from the northwest corner of the original corporate limits of Ewing, Kentucky, then continuing south along the original western corporate limits 975 feet to a point 106 feet north of the southwest corner of the original corporate limits of Ewing, Kentucky.

The three parcels are contiguous to the current incorporated boundaries of the city of Ewing, Kentucky.

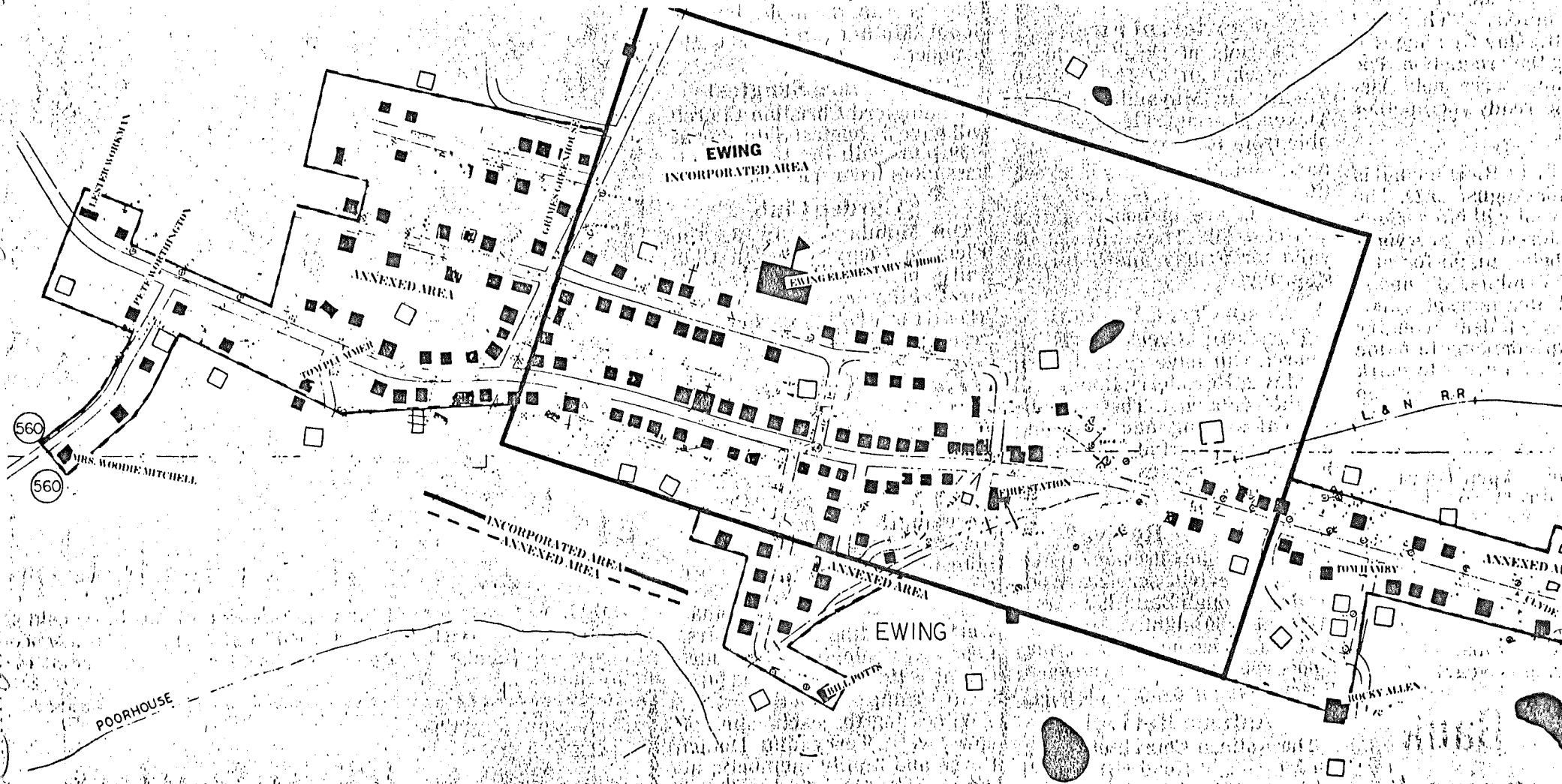
