JUDGMENT

This action coming on to be heard and it appearing to the Court from the record herein, that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in two issues of the Courier-Journal on September 15, 1953, and September 18th, 1953, said newspaper being of general circulation and published in Jefferson County, Kentucky; and it further appearing to the Court, and the Court being sufficiently advised on the petition herein, that the population within the boundary described in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of the law in such cases, and no defense or objection having been made, it is now ordered, adjudged and decreed:

1. That a city by the name of "FAIRMEADE" be and the same is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class, within the following described boundary, as shown by the map filed with the petition herein, and more particularly described as follows:

"BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of U. S. 60, or Shelbyville Road, and Fairmeade Road; running thence with the South line of U. S. 60, or Shelbyville Road, South 88°44'30" West 350 feet to a point; thence South 3° East 203.13 feet to a point in the Southwesterly line of Fairmeade Subdivision; thence South 37°55' East 1994.70 feet to a point in the South line of said Subdivision; thence North 52°15'30" East 965.37 feet to a point in the Easterly line of said Subdivision; thence North 38° West 1131.13 feet to a point in the Easterly line of said Subdivision; thence

North 88°44'30" West 273 feet; thence North 38° West 342.59 feet to a point in the South line of U. S. Highway 60, or Shelbyville Road; thence South 88°44'30" West 469.87 feet to the point of beginning; and being all of FAIRMEADE SUBDIVISION, plat of which is recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 9, Page 73, in the office of the County Court Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky, except for the Westerly 50 feet of Lot No. 1, Block A, which was sold by Wakefield to the Spur Distributing Company, Inc., by deed dated August 17, 1950, recorded in Deed Book 2657, Page 424, in said office.

2. That there are hereby appointed as Board of Trustees of the said city of Fairmeade, the following named persons, to-wit:

In addition to the Trustees named above, the following additional officers are appointed, to-wit:

Charles J. Daub, Assessor, 121 Fairmeade Road  
B. M. Meyers, Police  
Judge, 211 Hemingway  
Robert H. Klass, Marshal, 202 Fairmeade Road.

Each of the Trustees and Officers shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected. Qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law, by taking the respective oaths of office and executing respective bonds and obligations as may be prescribed by law, a record of which shall be entered upon the records of said city and copies thereof certified.

3. That the Clerk of the Court, not later than ten days after the judgment is entered herein, certify a copy of this Judgment to the Secretary of State in Frankfort, Kentucky, whose duty it shall be to properly index and file the same as a permanent record in his office.
