AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FERGUSON, KENTUCKY ANNEXING A TERRITORY OF LAND CONTIGUOUS TO THE EXISTING CITY LIMITS OF FERGUSON, KENTUCKY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FERGUSON, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the hereinafter described territory is urban in character and/or suitable for development for urban purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that no part of the area to be annexed shall be nor currently is included in the boundary of another city; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to KRS 81A.425 notice was sent on April 12, 2012 by first-class mail to each property owner listed on the records of the Pulaski County Property Valuation Administrator as of January 1, 2012, being the County of Pulaski, Kentucky; and

WHEREAS, said notice was mailed no later than fourteen (14) days prior to the meeting at which the ordinance proposing the annexation and stating the intention of the City of Ferguson to annex the territory received its second reading; and
