ORDINANCE NO. 769

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO ANNEX TO THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, A CERTAIN TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND AT THE WESTERN CITY LIMITS AND SOUTH OF THE FRANKFORT PIKE, FOR THE PURPOSE OF MUNICIPAL EXPANSION AND SEWER IMPROVEMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Whereas, the City of Georgetown is developing, particularly in a western and southern direction, particularly in the area of Royal Spring Addition in and around Kentucky Avenue; property on the western side of Kentucky Avenue is without City fire and police protection, free garbage collection service, advantages of City schools, and particularly without sewers and adequate water lines; that in order to provide a modern sewer system for Royal Spring Addition in the area of Caudill Avenue, Montgomery Avenue, extended, Kentucky Avenue, West Clinton Street, certain portions of Hill Street, and other areas in or near the western edge of Georgetown, it is necessary that a pumping station be constructed and placed in or along a certain branch of North Elkhorn Creek which drains an area west of Kentucky Avenue, and which branch runs almost parallel to Kentucky Avenue several hundred feet west of said street; and it appearing that annexation of the hereinafter described territory will inure to the benefit of the City of Georgetown and its inhabitants and also will provide advantages to the inhabitants and property in the territory to be annexed, particularly in view of the fact that one or more new factories are now being constructed or will be constructed in the near future in or near the city limits of Georgetown, Kentucky, and there are presently many houses being constructed in the area west of Kentucky Avenue; the Board of Council of the City of

Georgetown hereby deems it desirable, and hereby proposes to annex to the City of Georgetown all of that unincorporated territory lying in Scott County, Kentucky, and contiguous and adjacent to the present limits of said city, so that the boundaries of said City of Georgetown shall be changed as hereinafter set forth to include and embrace the following described real property:

A parcel of land lying along the Western City Limits of Georgetown, Scott County, Kentucky, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a pin in the south right-of-way line of U. S. Highways 62 & 227, (Commonly known as West Main Street) and the east R/W line of Kentucky Avenue, which point is the existing city limits of Georgetown, Kentucky. Thence down the south right-of-way line of U.S. 62 & 227, N. 86° 30' west 878.00 feet to a new creosoted post; said post being in the fence line between the highway right-of-way and the property of Vertna Hawkins Mason; thence along the line of Mason S. 0° 15' E. 175.80 feet to a new creosoted post, S. 30° 45' E 408.00 feet to a new post and S. 32° 15' E 420.00 feet to a new post located in the property line between Vertna Hawkins Mason and Lewis Watson; thence along the property of Watson S. 27° 30' E 401.80 feet to a new post and S. 30° 10' E 607.80 feet to a new post in the property line between Mrs. Artie Risk and Lewis Watson, said point being also in the present city limits line; thence along the present city limits line N 2° 14' W 717.00 feet to a point in the north right-of-way line of Clinton Street and the east right-of-way line of Kentucky Avenue; thence along the east right-of-way line of Kentucky Avenue N 0° 20' E 1007.10 feet to the point of beginning; said tract of land containing .027 square miles; the above description being according to new survey of J. R. Miller, Jr., registered civil engineer, dated July 29, 1956.

Section 2. After the passage and publication of this Ordinance as required by K.R.S. 81.210 and 81.220, the City Attorney is hereby directed to file a petition in the Scott Circuit Court praying for the annexation of the above described territory to the City of Georgetown; and the City Attorney is further directed to take all steps necessary and proper in such proceeding to carry such suit to a successful conclusion for the annexation of the above described boundary to the present boundaries of the City of Georgetown.

Section 3. If any section, subsection, clause, phrase, word, or other part of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions.

Section 4. All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, but no further.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective upon its passage and publication as provided by law.

WHEREUPON, upon motion of Councilman Scroggin, seconded by Councilman Johnson, and by vote of the Council as follows:

This Ordinance was adopted and passed, and the Mayor declared the same to be approved, this 4th day of April, 1957.
