ORDINANCE NO. 81 - 011

AN ORDINANCE PROPOSING TO ANNEX TO THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TRACTS OR PARCELS OF LAND ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF U.S. 460 AND ON THE WEST SIDE OF U.S. 25 SOUTH

WHEREAS, the City of Georgetown, Kentucky, a city of the fourth class, desires to annex certain territory;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Georgetown, a city of the fourth class, does desire, and hereby proposes, to annex to the corporate limits of said city the following described property:

TRACT NO. 1

That certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Scott County, Kentucky, on the south side of U.S. 460 west of the present limits of the City of Georgetown, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the center of U.S. 460 and 62 west in the existing city limits, thence running with the center of said road in a western direction 1420 feet, more or less, to a corner to Hillside Professional Partnership and Williams; thence running S 30°15'E, with the western boundary of Hillside Professional Partnership and the eastern boundary of Williams and Ruggles Sign Co., 643 feet to the line of Old Armstrong Place and the existing city limits; thence running with the existing city limits for the following: continuing 53°15'E with Old Armstrong Place 722 feet to a corner; S 86° 31'E, 455 feet to a corner; thence with the line of Old Armstrong Place and Indian Hill #3, N 77° 58'E 1290 feet, more or less, to a corner; thence S 17° 32'E, 452 feet, more or less, with the line of Indian Hills #3 to a corner; thence with the line of Indian Hills N 66° 36'E, 564 feet, more or less to a corner; thence in a northern direction to the point of beginning; it is the intention of this description to expand the western city limits to include all of the area not now included that lies south of U.S. 460-62 and east of the western boundary of Hillside Professional Partnership property.

TRACT NO. 2

That certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in Scott County, Kentucky, on the west of U.S. 25 South, and more particularly described as follows:


Beginning at a point in the east right-of-way of US 25 south, said point being in line with the extended northern boundary line of Hardee's, in the existing city limits; thence N 84° 55'W, 212 feet, more

or less, with the northern boundary of Hardee's to the line of Ford & Bradley; thence with lines of Ford & Bradley S 40° 18' W, 50 feet; thence S 45° 02' W, 102.5 feet; thence S 49° 59' W, 34.87 feet; thence S 51° 30' W, 143.0 feet; thence S 59° 45' W, 140.0 feet; thence S 64° W, 120.0 feet; thence S 70° 30' W, 145.0 feet; thence S 76° 20' W, 160.0 feet; thence S 77° W, 356.3 feet to a corner to Muir; thence with the line of Muir S 69° 22' W, 1108.3 feet; to a corner to Ford & Bradley; thence with the line of Ford & Bradley; S 24° W, 505.4 feet to a corner to Parker Bradley; thence with the lines of Parker Bradley N 69° 22' E, 745 feet; S 20° 38' E, 125 feet; N 69° 22' E, 668 feet to a corner to Bluegrass Cinema; thence with the lines of Bluegrass Cinema N 1° 17' W, 135.2 feet; N 69° 22' E, 160 feet to a point; thence S 87° 54' E, 313.7 feet; thence S 85° 45' E, 296.4 feet; thence S 81° 16' E, 210 feet, more or less to the east side of U.S. 25; thence N 6° 45' E, 80 feet, more or less, to a corner; thence N 83° 05' W, 235 feet, more or less, to a corner; thence N 7° 02' E, 977 feet to a corner to the American Legion North property line, thence S 82° 58' E, 255 feet, more or less, to the east side of U.S. 25 and the existing city limit; thence in a northern direction, with the existing city limit 250 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.


SECTION 2. Upon passage and publication of this ordinance, persons desiring to file objections to the annexation of the above described properties must file such objections in the Office of the Mayor, City Hall, Georgetown, Kentucky, within 60 days from the date hereof.

The City Attorney is directed to file a map describing thereon the territory to be annexed in the office of the Scott County Clerk, along with a list of property owners in the area proposed to be annexed.

WHEREUPON, the above ordinance was passed and approved this 17th day of December, 1981.
