ORDINANCE NO. 83-010

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF
GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, CERTAIN TRACTS
OR PARCELS OF LAND ON THE EASE SIDE
OF US 25 SOUTH AND ON THE WEST
SIDE OF US 25 SOUTH

WHEREAS, the City of Georgetown, Kentucky a city of the fourth class has by Ordinance No. 83-001 expressed its intention to annex certain territory described in said Ordinance and as described hereinafter, and;

WHEREAS, in accordance with KRS 81A.420 (1) Ordinance No. 83-001 was given first reading on April 7, 1983, read for the second time passed and approved on April 21, 1983, published according to KRS Chapter 424 and became effective on April 28, 1983, and;

WHEREAS, it now appearing that more than 60 days have passed since the effective date of Ordinance No. 83-001; no person having filed with the Mayor a petition in opposition to said annexation in accordance with KRS 81A.420 (2); the Council now declares that the hereinafter described property shall be annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Georgetown and shall become part of same, and;

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has prepared a map of the territory to be annexed, listing thereon the names of all property owners in said area proposed to be annexed and same having been filed with the office of the Scott County Court Clerk, in accordance with the provisions of KRS 81A.475.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF GEORGETOWN, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with KRS 81A.420 (1) (3), the City of Georgetown, a city of the fourth class, does hereby annex to the corporate limits of said city the following described property:

Beginning at a point in the existing city limits, said point being the corner between the property of Georgetown Airport, Walmart (formerly Blue Grass Cinema) and Bridges, thence running in a southern direction with the line of Walmart S

0°50'W, 306.56 feet more or less to a corner, thence N 89°56'E, 291.83 feet to an iron pin and a corner to Kroger; thence S 12°26'E with the line of Kroger 391.34 feet to an iron pin corner to Bridger; thence with the line of Bridges N 69°E 625 feet more or less to the center of U.S. 25; thence in a southern direction with the center of said highway 1203 feet more or less to a point in line with the extended property line of Robinson and Hospital Corporation of America (formerly Walton); thence leaving the highway N 70°E with the line of H.C.A. and Robinson 1053.31 feet to a corner, thence N 19°22'W, 688.36 feet to corner to Mt. Vernon subdivision and the existing city limit; thence with 3 lines of said subdivision and existing city limit N 66°16'W, 326.93 feet; N 21°45'E 549.86 feet; N 55°50' W, 294.71 feet to a corner with Walton; thence leaving the existing city limit and running with the line of Walton and H.C.A. S 21°45'W, 183.51 feet; S 83°58'W, 777.94 feet to the center of U.S. 25 thence with the center of said highway in a northern direction forty feet more or less to a corner between Walmart and Taylor Rental; thence leaving said highway with the line of Walmart and Taylor Rental N 82°10'W, 290.51 feet; N 39°12'W, 223.84 feet to a corner with the City of Georgetown (airport property), thence N 88°30'W, 272.67 feet with the line of city and Walmart to a corner; thence S 69°36'W, 155.87 feet to a corner; thence S 0°50'W, 132.5 feet to the point of beginning and containing 46 acres more or less.

SECTION 2. Upon passage and publication of this Ordinance the foregoing described property shall become a part of the corporate limits of said city, and shall be entitled to the benefits of all services provided by said city.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication.

WHEREUPON, the foregoing Ordinance was read for the first time on July 7, 1983, read for the second time under suspension of rules, on July 7, 1983, passed and approved this 7th day of July, 1983.
