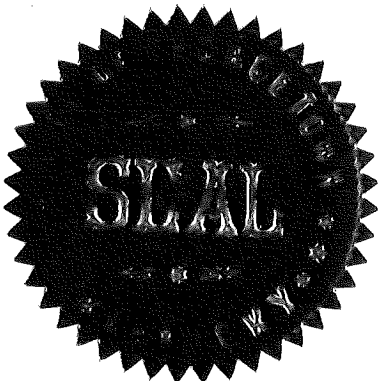

**CITY OF GEORGETOWN**  
**ORDINANCE NO. 99- 48**

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN CONTIGUOUS REAL ESTATE TO THE CITY OF GEORGETOWN CONSISTING OF APPROXIMATELY 3.68 ACRES LOCATED OFF OF EAST MAIN STREET-EXTENDED.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Georgetown desires to incorporate into its boundaries certain unincorporated territory which lies contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Georgetown; and,

**WHEREAS**, the subject unincorporated territory due to its location and proximity to the present boundaries of the City of Georgetown and certain essential urban services, i.e. water, sanitary sewer, electric, roads and proposed highways is urban in character and is suitable for urban purposes and development without unreasonable delay; and,

**WHEREAS**, the subject, unincorporated territory lies within the present urban service boundary under the Georgetown-Scott County Joint Planning and Zoning Commission current comprehensive plan and development scheme; and,

**WHEREAS**, the development of the hereinafter described unincorporated territory will provide an economic and social benefit to the City of Georgetown by permitting appropriate urban use and development of this property in the City of Georgetown; and,

**WHEREAS**, no part of the land sought to be annexed lies within the incorporated boundaries of any other city or county; and,

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to KRS 81A-412 the owners of the subject unincorporated territory have given their written consent to the proposed annexation, which consent forms are collectively attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GEORGETOWN CITY COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section I:** The City of Georgetown, by these presents, with the written consent of the owners of the real property which is the subject of this annexation ordinance, which consent is attached hereto collectively as Exhibit A does hereby annex that certain real property which is described herein in Exhibit B to be incorporated into the boundaries of the City of Georgetown. The subject real estate described in Exhibit B is contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Georgetown.

**Section II:** The City of Georgetown is annexing the real estate described in Exhibit B attached hereto in order to foster and encourage appropriate urban use and development in the City of Georgetown. The proposed use of the above described

property will be in conformance with present use the subject property. The subject property is contiguous to the City of Georgetown, is suitable for urban development, and is desirable to be annexed to the City of Georgetown.

**Section III:** That the Georgetown City Clerk is by these presents directed to file with the Kentucky Secretary of State, the Scott County Clerk, and the Commonwealth of Kentucky Department of Local Government, an accurate map and metes and bounds description of the territory annexed, along with a certified copy of this ordinance; pursuant to KRS 81A.470; and to further file with the Scott County Clerk the names and addresses of property owners and registered voters residing in the territory annexed pursuant to KRS 81A.475.

**Section IV:** That this ordinance was read for the first time on NOV. 4 and for the second time on NOV. 18, 1999, and will be effective upon passage and publication in the Georgetown News-Graphic as required by law.

Beginning at a corner to Wells & Nally & Gibson, said corner being 294.01 feet northeast of the center of Main Street Extended as measured along the line fence between Wells & Drake; thence with a new line S 31° 31' 44" E, 153.15 feet to a new corner; thence N 53° 59' 11" E, 264.21 feet to a multiple trunk maple tree; thence N 16° 17' 53" E, 363.64 feet to the center of an existing gate; thence continuing on the same course 117.09 feet to the center of Elkhorn Creek; thence with the center of said creek N 64° 17' 35" W to a point; thence S 30° 13' 44" W, 449.18 feet to the point of beginning and containing 2.8801 acres.
