JUDGMENT INCORPORATING  
GLENVIEW MANOR

This action having been submitted to this Court for the incorporation of GLENVIEW MANOR as a Sixth Class City, and it appearing to the Court that more than 125 inhabitants reside within the boundaries proposed to be established for said City, and that the boundaries will not exceed one-half mile in each direction, and that the form of the city is square; and it further appearing that the Petition to incorporate this city was signed by more than two-thirds of the voters living within the boundaries of the proposed City, and it further appearing that notice of the filing of the Petition and of its object has been given by publication in two issues, namely, of April 17th and 19th, 1965, of the Louisville Times, a newspaper of general circulation, published in this County, it is, therefore, ordered and adjudged:

1. That the hereinafter described area is hereby established as a city of the sixth class.
2. That the name of said City is GLENVIEW MANOR.
3. That the metes and bounds description of said City is as follows:

Said property is generally bounded on the West by Glenview Avenue, the East by Line Rihn Lane, the North by LINDSEY MANOR and on the South by WINDWOOD SUBDIVISIONS, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING in Glenview Avenue, at a point therein which is 30 feet Southwestwardly from its original Northeast line and 15 feet Northeastwardly from

its original Southwest line, which point is North 33 degrees 27 minutes West 819.77 feet and North 33 degrees 24 minutes West 828.41 feet from the Northwest line of U. S. Highway 42, as widened, as shown on the Plat of WYNNEWOOD SUBDIVISION, Section No. 1, which is recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 13, Page 87, in the Office of the County Court Clerk of Jefferson County, Kentucky, said beginning point being the Northwest corner of said WYNNEWOOD SUBDIVISION; running thence with said Glenview Avenue, 30 feet from said Northeast line and 15 feet from said Southwest line, North 33 degrees 26 minutes 30 seconds West 891.13 feet to the corner to Lloyd A. Kupp; thence with same and the line of LIMBILN MANOR, as shown on the Plat of same which is recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 13, Page 54, in said office, North 56 degrees 30 minutes East 1975.90 feet to the original Southwest line of Lime Kiln Lane; thence with said line of Lime Kiln Lane, South 32 degrees 53 minutes East 790.38 feet to the Baylor O. Hickman tract; thence with same and WYNNEWOOD SUBDIVISIONS, South 53 degrees 33 minutes West 1970.932 feet to the point of beginning, being all of the property as shown on the Plan of GLENVIEW MANOR, which is recorded in Plat and Subdivision Book 9, Page 106 in said office.

4. That William G. Davis, J. Miner Culp, Thomas N. French, John B. Whalen and Lawrence A. Glaser are hereby appointed as Trustees of the City of Stanton, Kentucky, and James H. Adams as Judge, Gilbert S. Adams as Marshal and Joseph E. Boslar as Assessor. They shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected.

5. The Clerk of this Court is hereby ordered and directed to certify a copy of this Judgment to the Secretary of State of the State of Kentucky at Frankfort, within 10 days after the signing of this Judgment, with instructions to said Secretary to properly index and file the same as a permanent record in his office.
