J U D G M E N T

This action coming on to be heard, and it appearing to the Court from the record herein that due notice of the filing of the petition herein and the object thereof has been published in three (3) issues of the The Louisville Times on October 12, 1959, October 19, 1959, and on October 26, 1959, said newspaper being of general circulation and publication in Jefferson County, Kentucky; and it further appearing to the Court, and the Court being sufficiently advised on the petition herein, that the population within the described boundary in said petition is sufficient to meet the requirements of the law in such cases, and no defense or objection having been made,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. That a city by the name of "GRAYMOOR" be and the same is hereby established as a municipal corporation of the sixth class, within the following described boundary, as shown on the map filed with the petition herein, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the most Southerly corner of the tract conveyed to John A. Walser and Richard J. Herrmann as Trustees by deed of record in Deed Book 3534, Page 183, in the office of the Clerk of the County Court of Jefferson County, Kentucky; thence Northwestwardly with the Southwesterly line of said tract and same extended 2480 feet; thence Northeastwardly and at right angles to said last mentioned line 2480 feet; thence Southeastwardly and parallel with the Southwesterly line of the tract conveyed to John A. Walser and Richard J. Herrmann as Trustees aforesaid, 2480 feet; thence Southwestwardly and at right angles to said last mentioned line 2480 feet to the point of beginning.

2. That there are hereby appointed as Board of Trustees of the said city of "Graymoor" the following named persons, to-wit:



Each of the trustees and officers shall hold their respective offices until the next election at which officers for cities and towns may be elected. Qualification of said officers shall be in the manner provided by law, by taking the respective oaths of office and executing respective bonds and obligations as may be prescribed by law, a record of which shall be entered upon the records of said city and copies thereof certified.

3. The Clerk of the Court, not later than 10 days after judgment is entered herein, shall certify a copy of this judgment to the Secretary of State in Frankfort, Kentucky, whose duty it shall be to properly index and file the same as a permanent record in her file.
